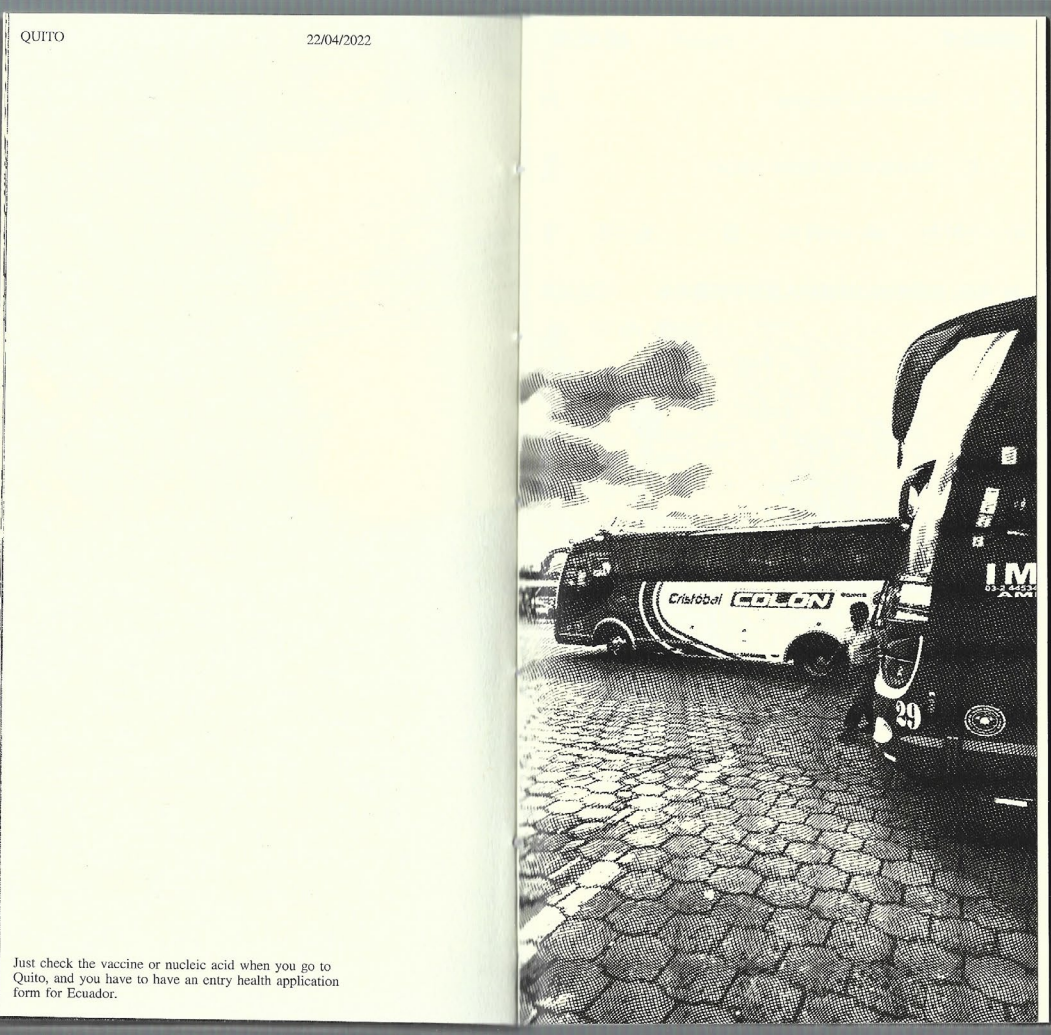
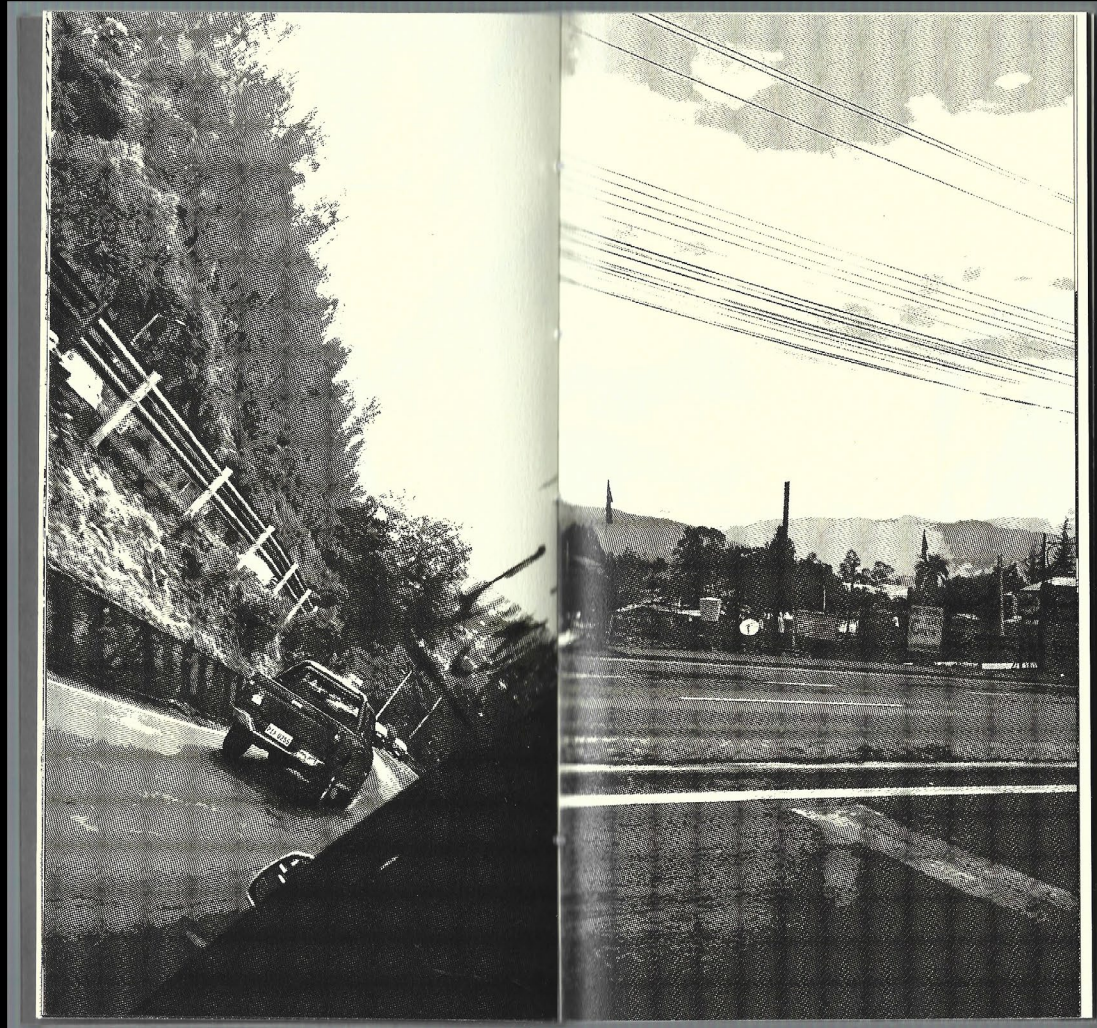
MADRID 21/04/2022

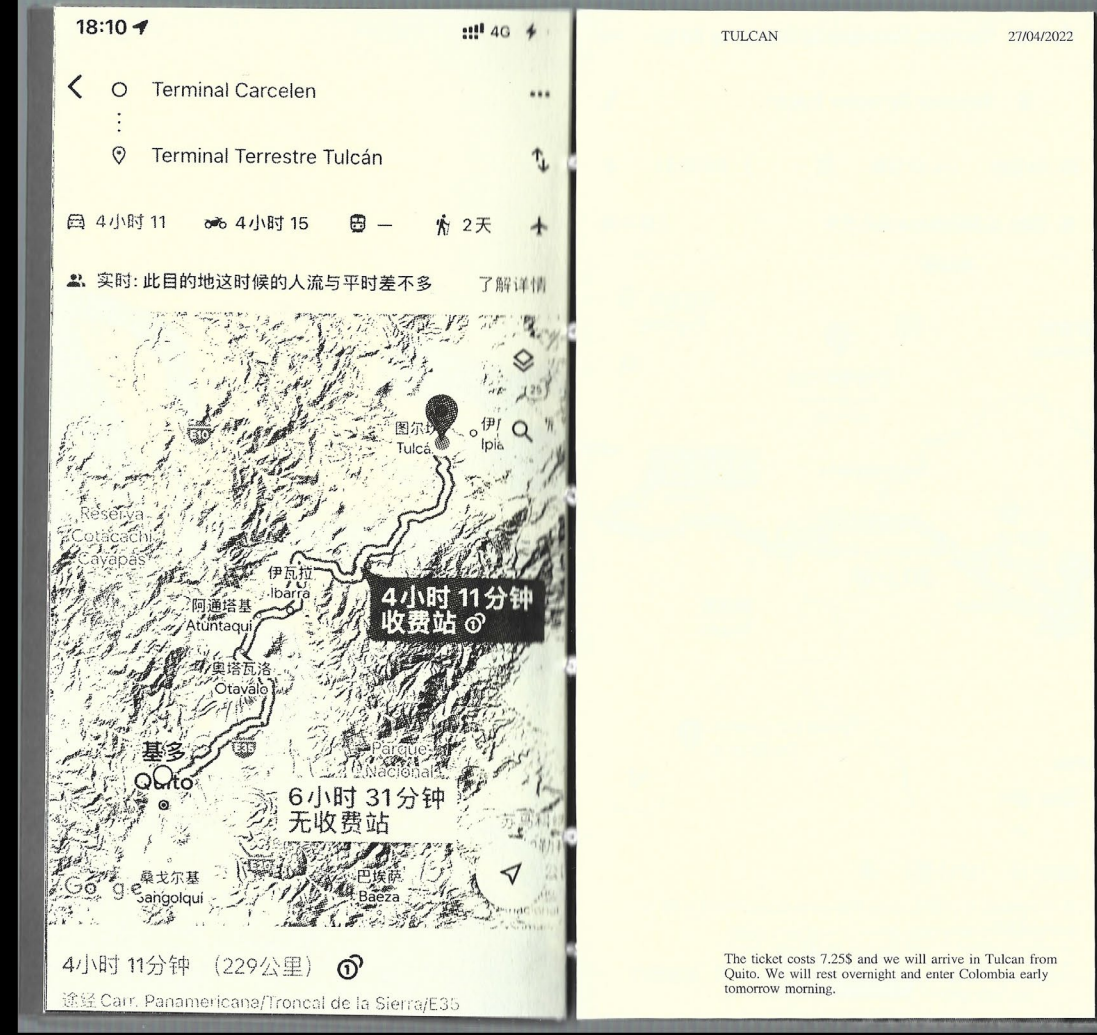

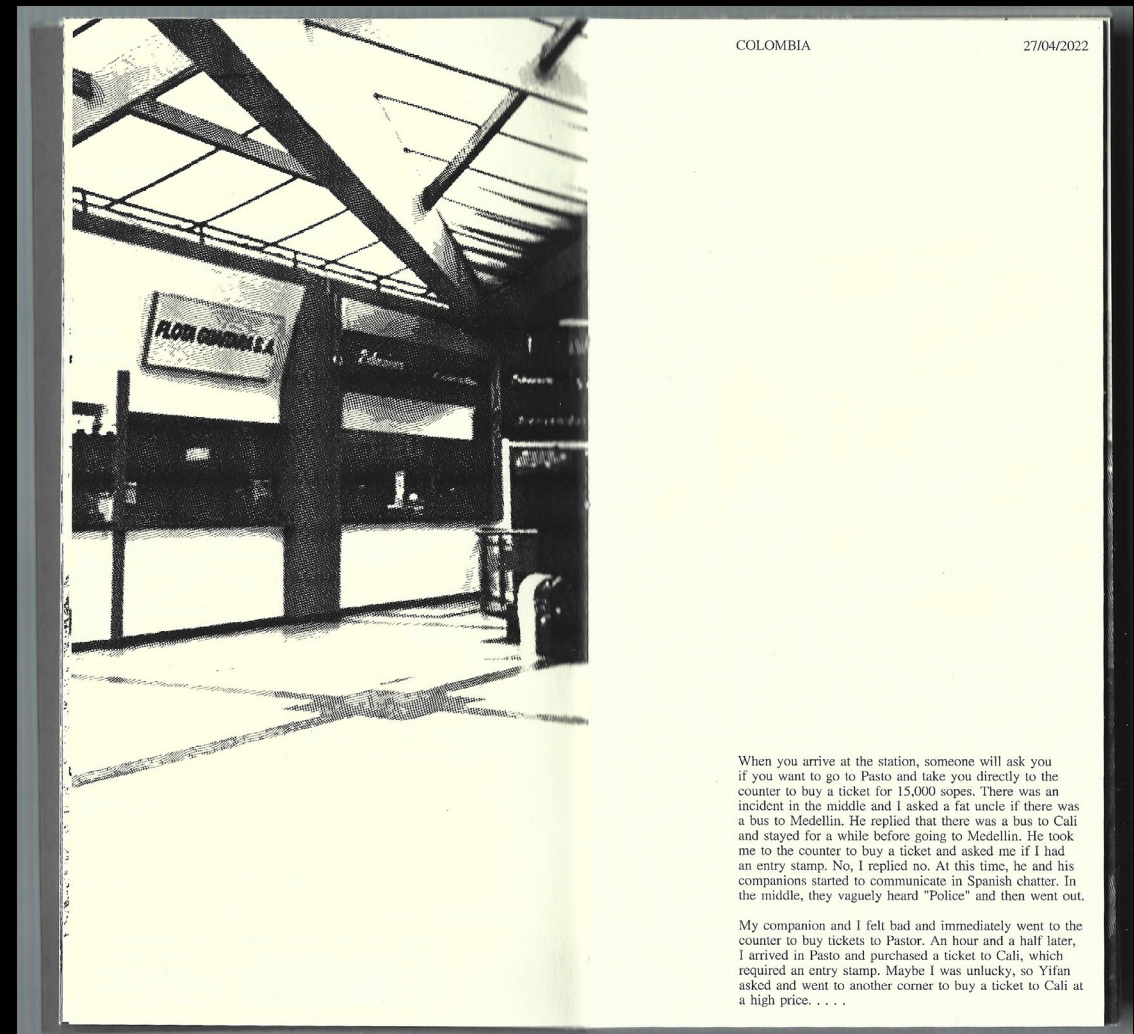

Just check the vaccine or nucleic acid when you go to Quito, and you have to have an entry health application form for Ecuador.

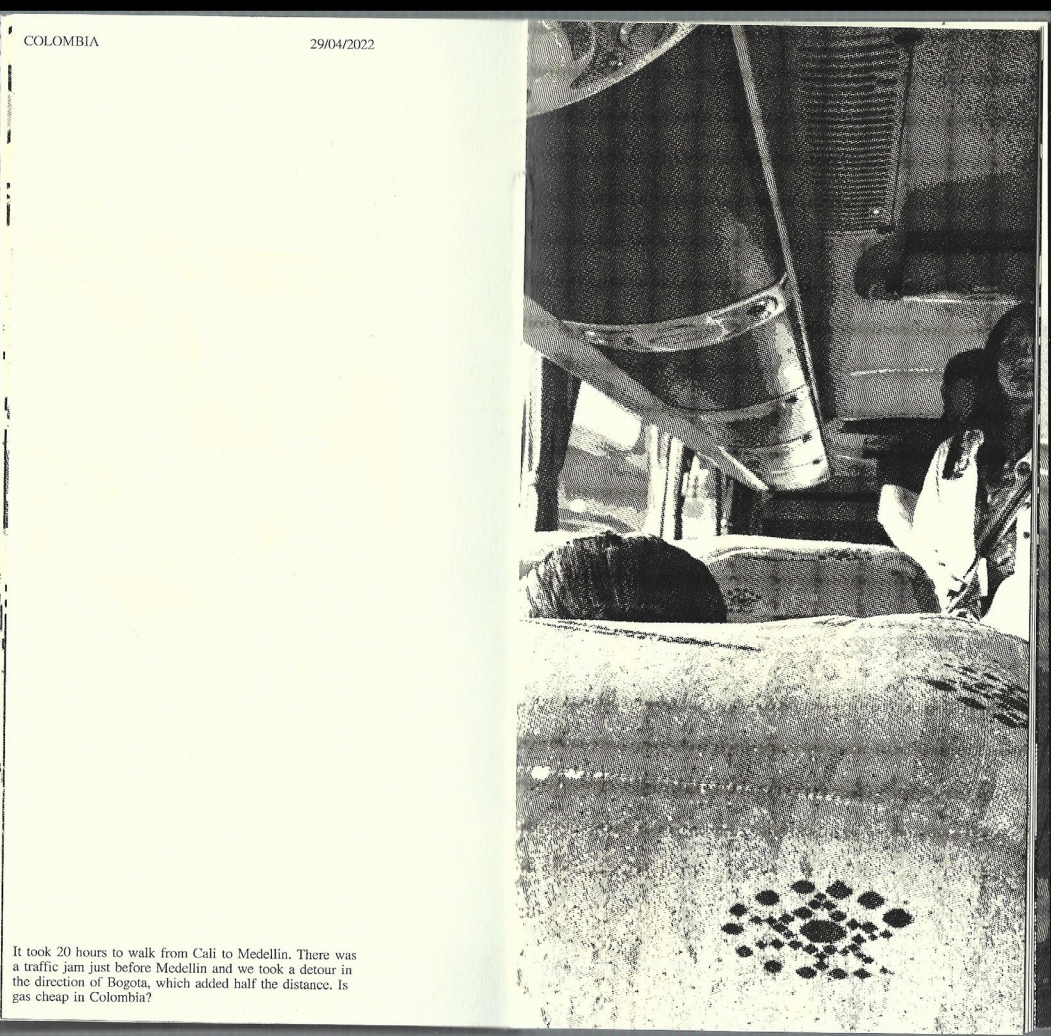


The ticket costs 7,255 and we will arrive in Tulcan from Quito. We will rest overnight and enter Colombia early tomorrow morning.

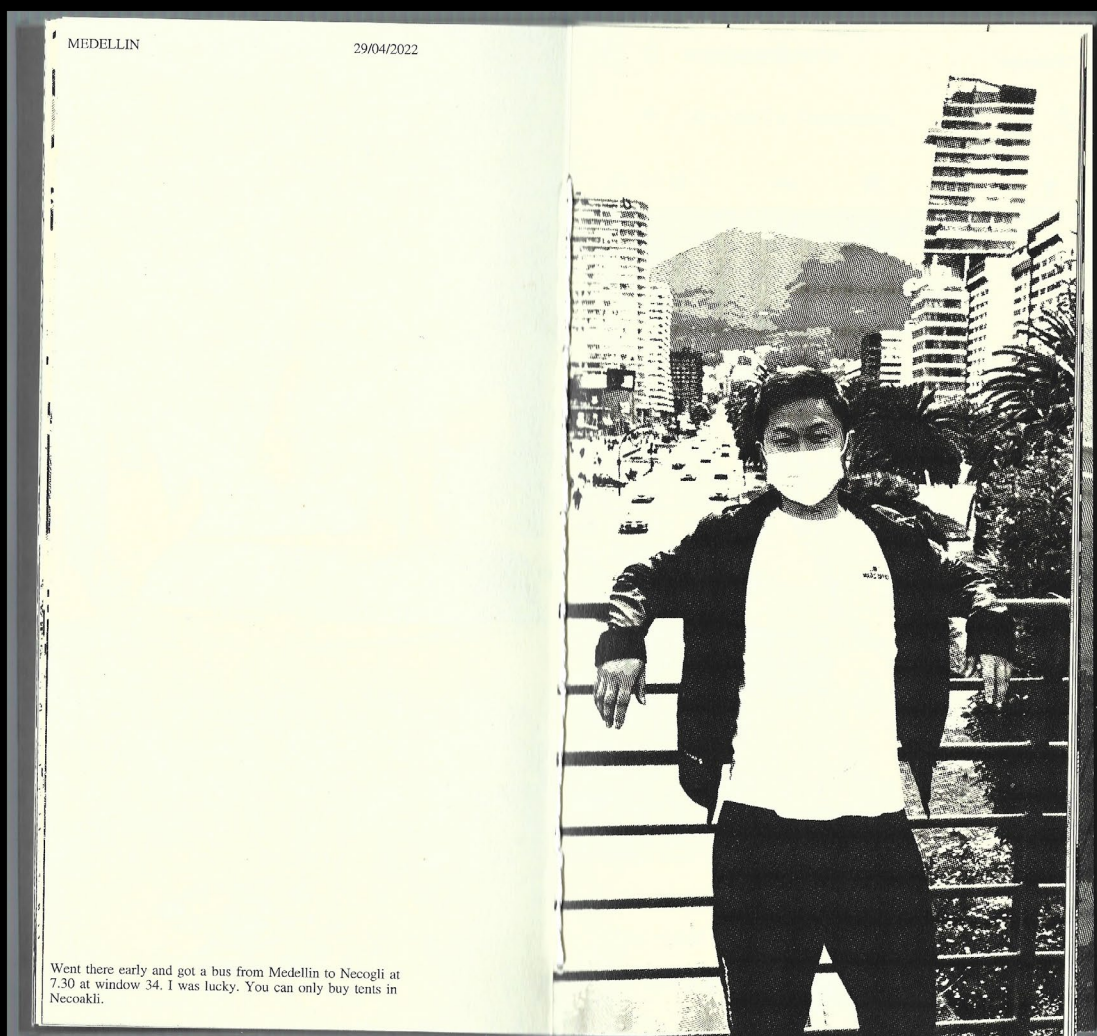


When you arrive at the station, someone will ask you if you want to go to Pasto and take you directly to the counter to buy a ticket for 15,000 pesos. There was an incident in the middle and I asked a fat uncle if there was a bus to Medellin. He replied that there was a bus to Cali and stayed for a while before going to Medellin. He took me to the counter to buy a ticket and asked me if I had an entry stamp. No, I replied so. At this time, he and his companions started to communicate in Spanish charter. In the middle, they vaguely heard "Police" and then went out.

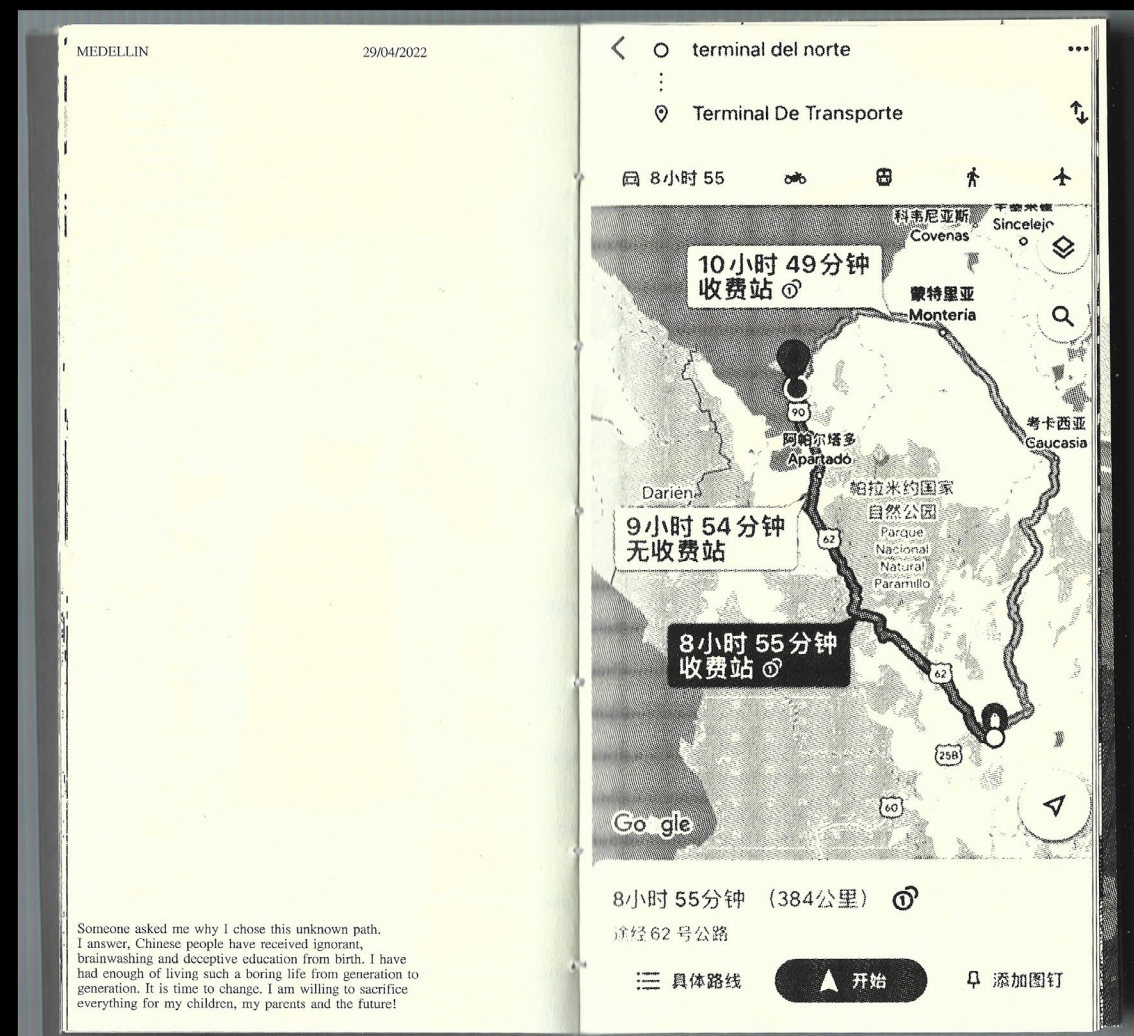
My companion and I felt bad and immediately went to the counter to buy tickets to Pasto. An hour and a half later, I arrived in Pasto and purchased a ticket to Cali, which required an entry stamp. Maybe I was unlucky, so Yifan asked and went to another corner to buy a ticket to Cali at a high price.



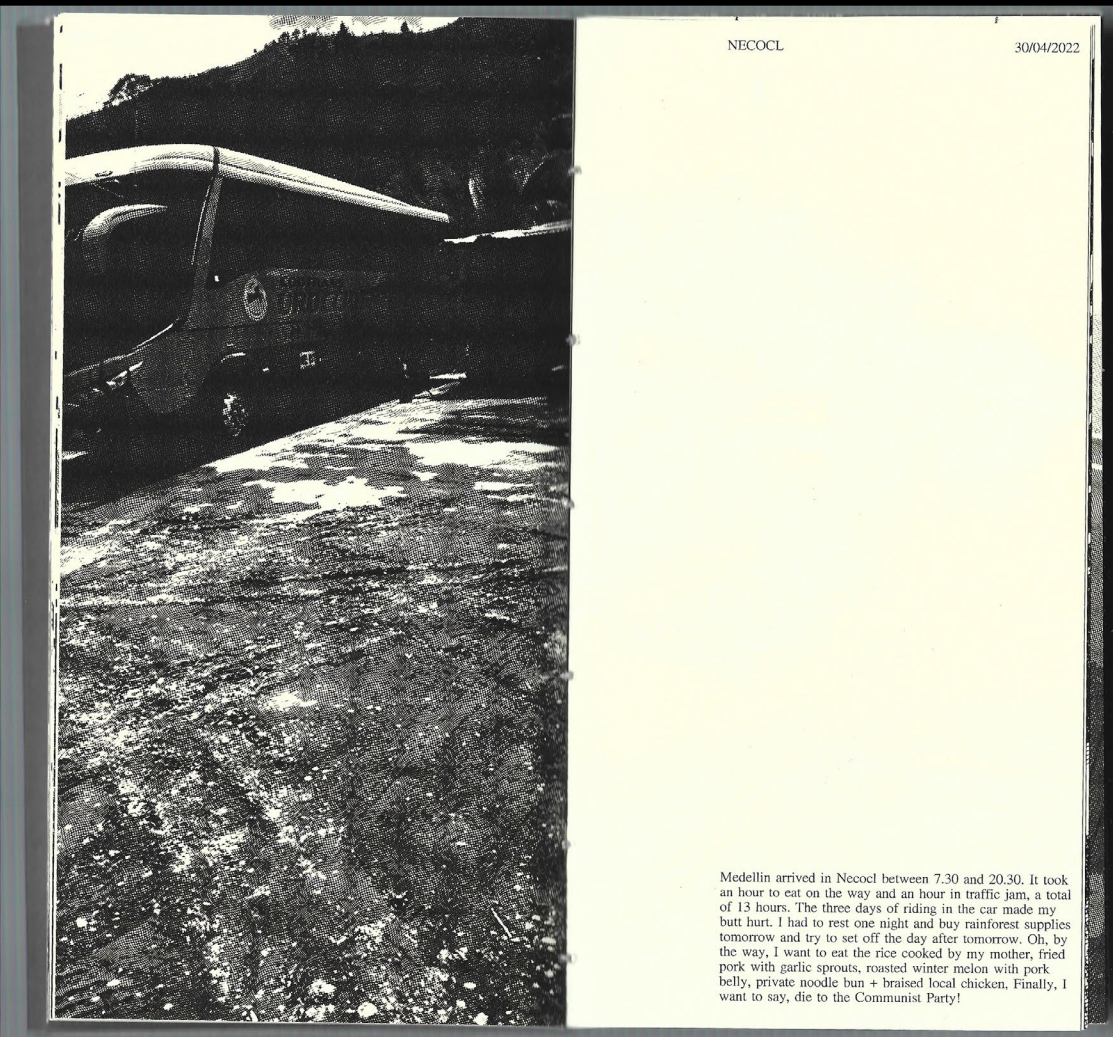
It took 20 hours to walk from Cali to Medellin. There was a traffic jam just before Medellin and we took a detour in the direction of Bogota, which added half the distance. Is gas cheap in Colombia?



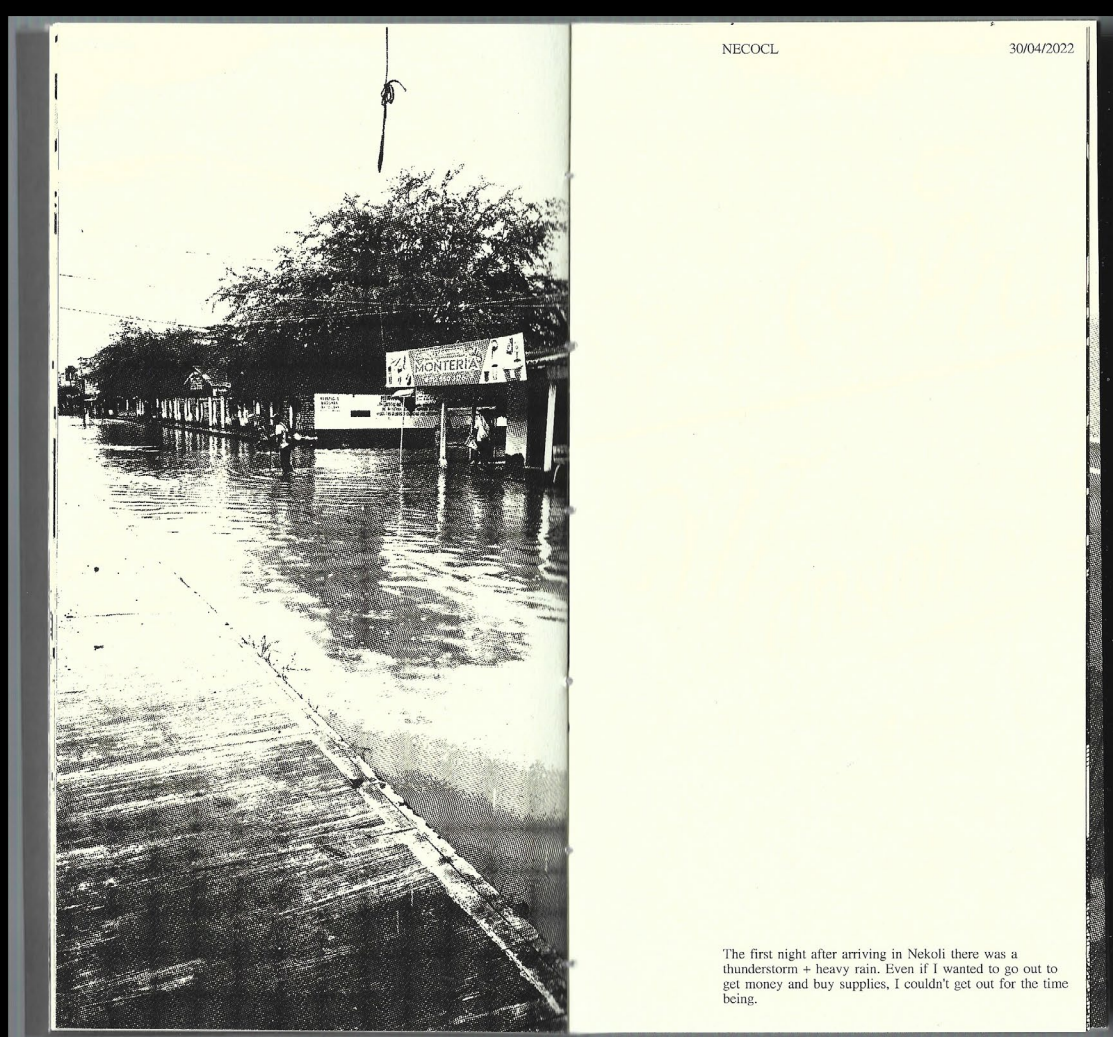
Went there early and got a bus from Medellin to Neocchi at 7:30 at window 34. I was lucky. You can only buy tents in Neocchi.



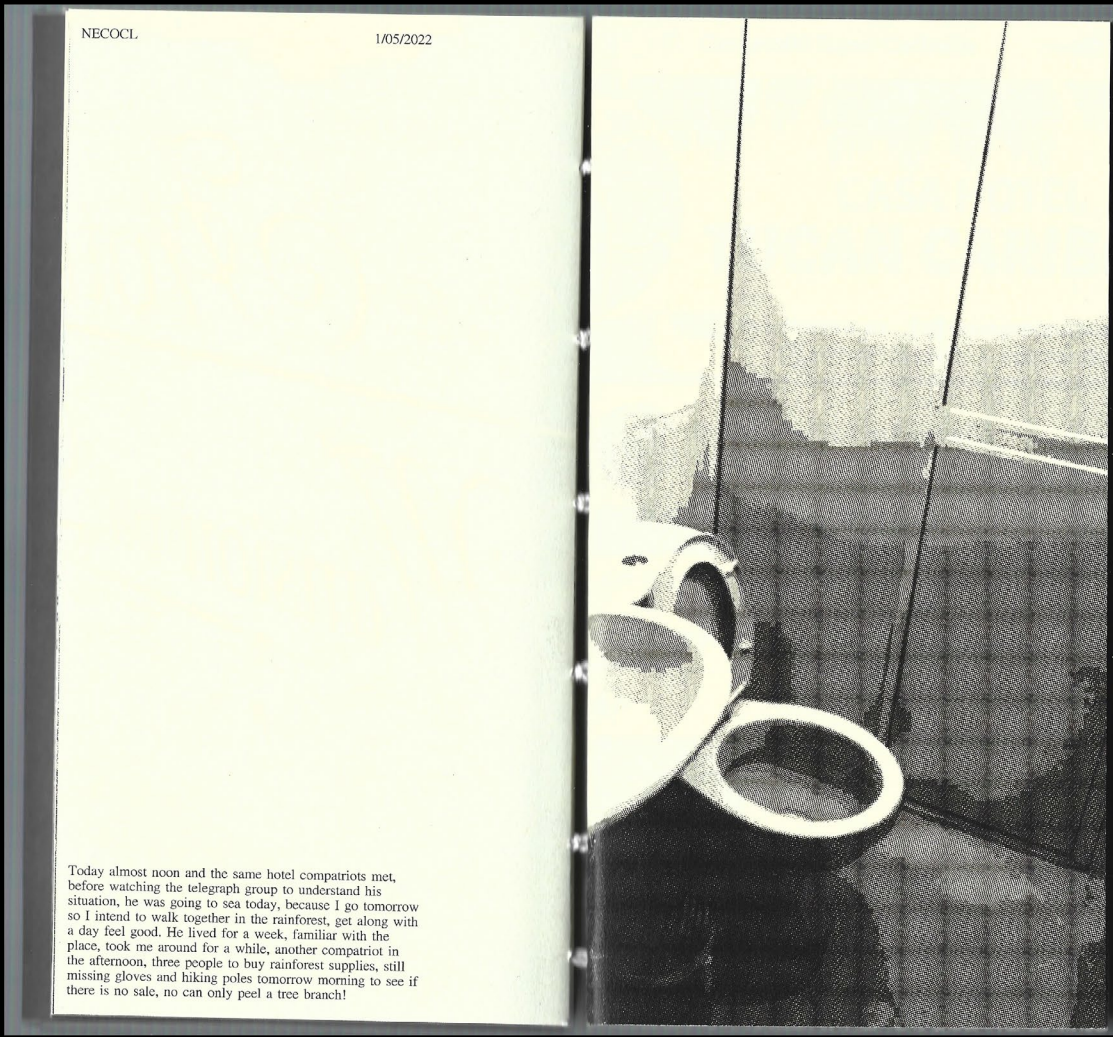
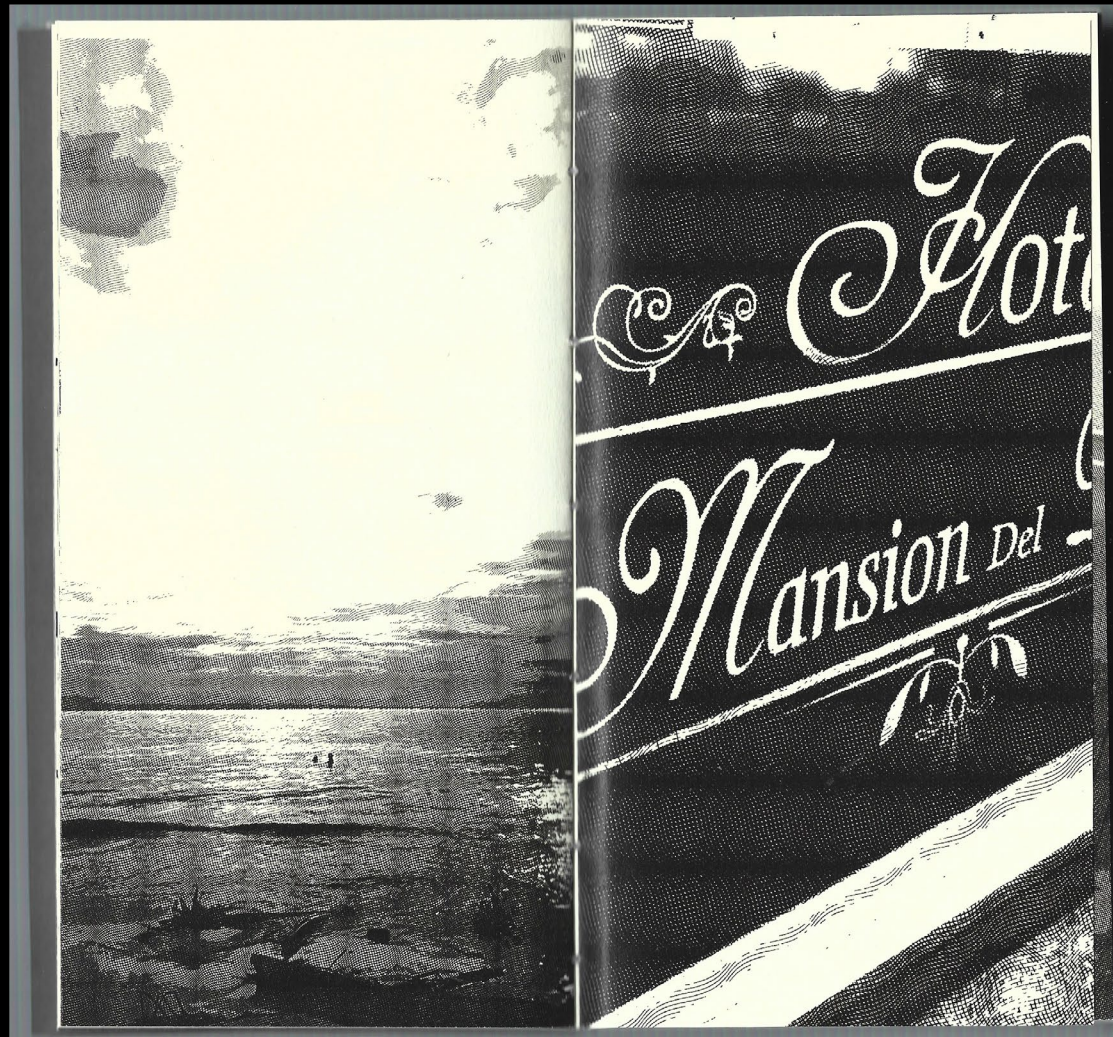

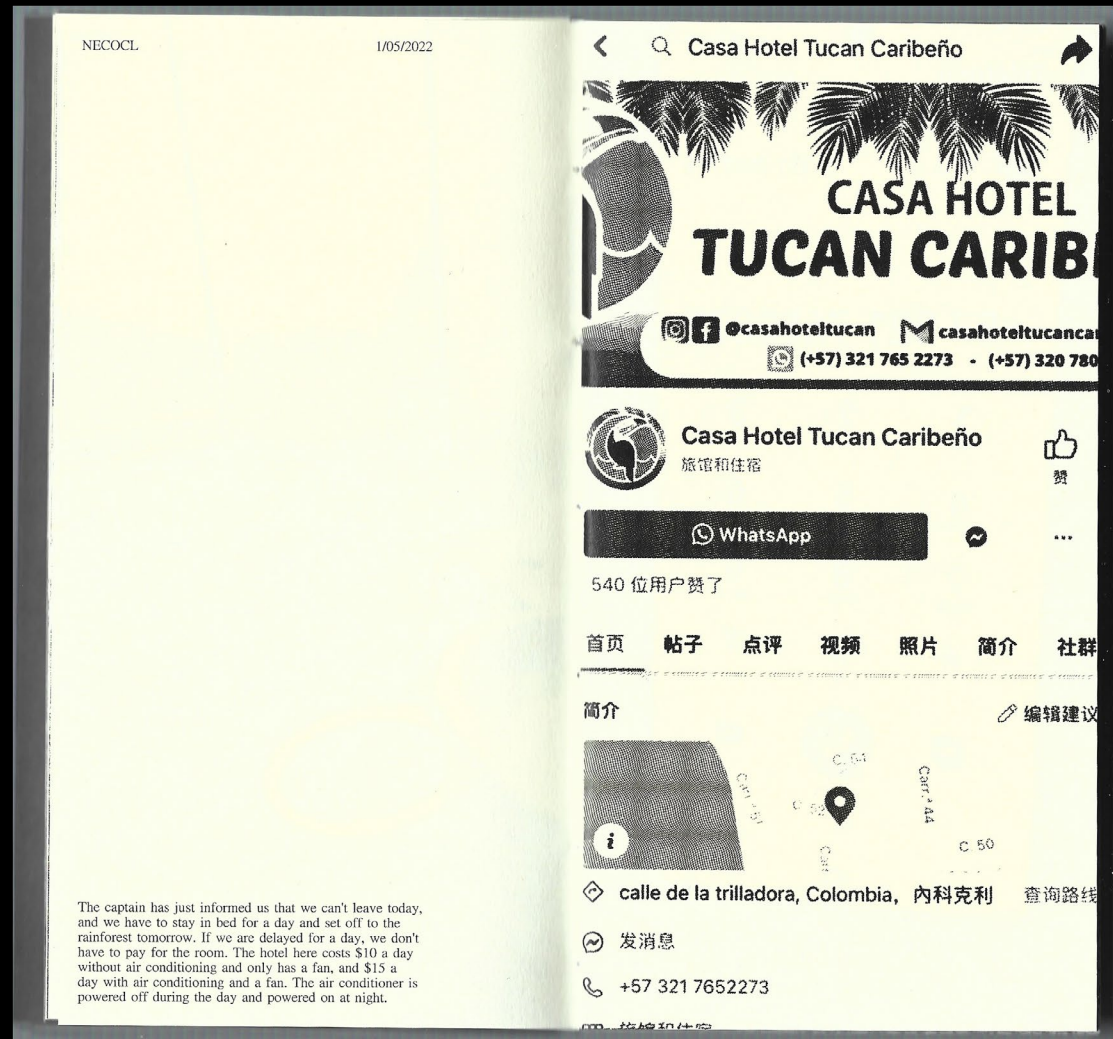
Madellin arrived in Necoclí between 7.30 and 20.30. It took an hour to get on the way and an hour in traffic jam, a total of 13 hours. The three days of riding in the car made my butt hurt. I had to rest one night and buy rainforest supplies tomorrow and try to set off the day after tomorrow. Oh, by the way, I want to eat the rice cooked by my mother, fried pork with garlic spices, roasted winter malons with pork belly, private noodle bun + braised local chicken. Finally, I want to say, die to the Communist Party!



The first night after arriving in Necoclí there was a thunderstorm + heavy rain. Even if I wanted to go out to get money and buy supplies, I couldn't get out for the time being.



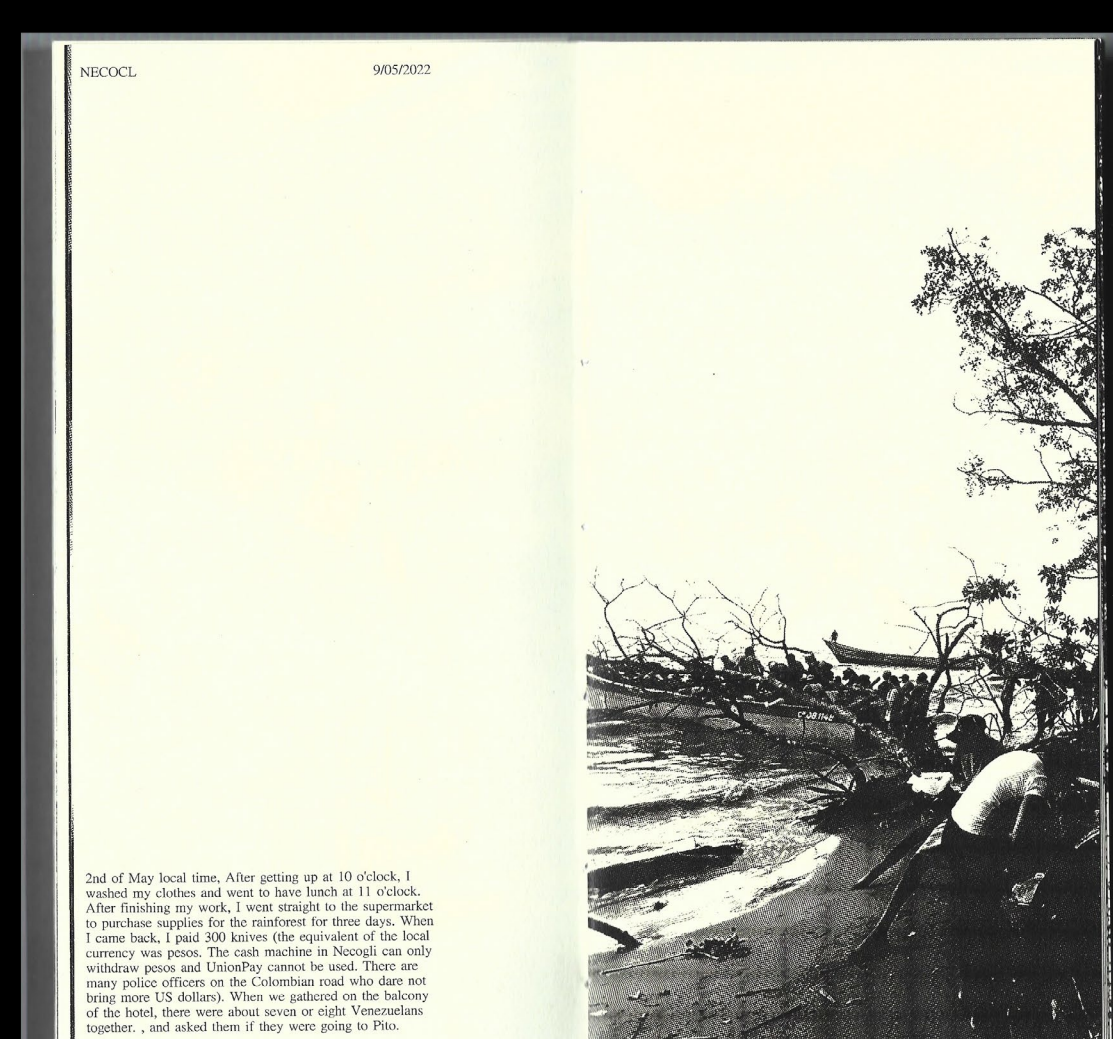
Today almost noon and the same hotel companion met, before watching the telegraph group to understand his situation, he was going to sea today, because I go tomorrow so I intend to walk together in the rainforest, get along with a day feel good. He lived for a week, familiar with the place, took me around for a while, another companion in the afternoon, three people to buy rainforest supplies, still missing gloves and hiking poles tomorrow morning to see if there is no safe, no can only post a tree branch!



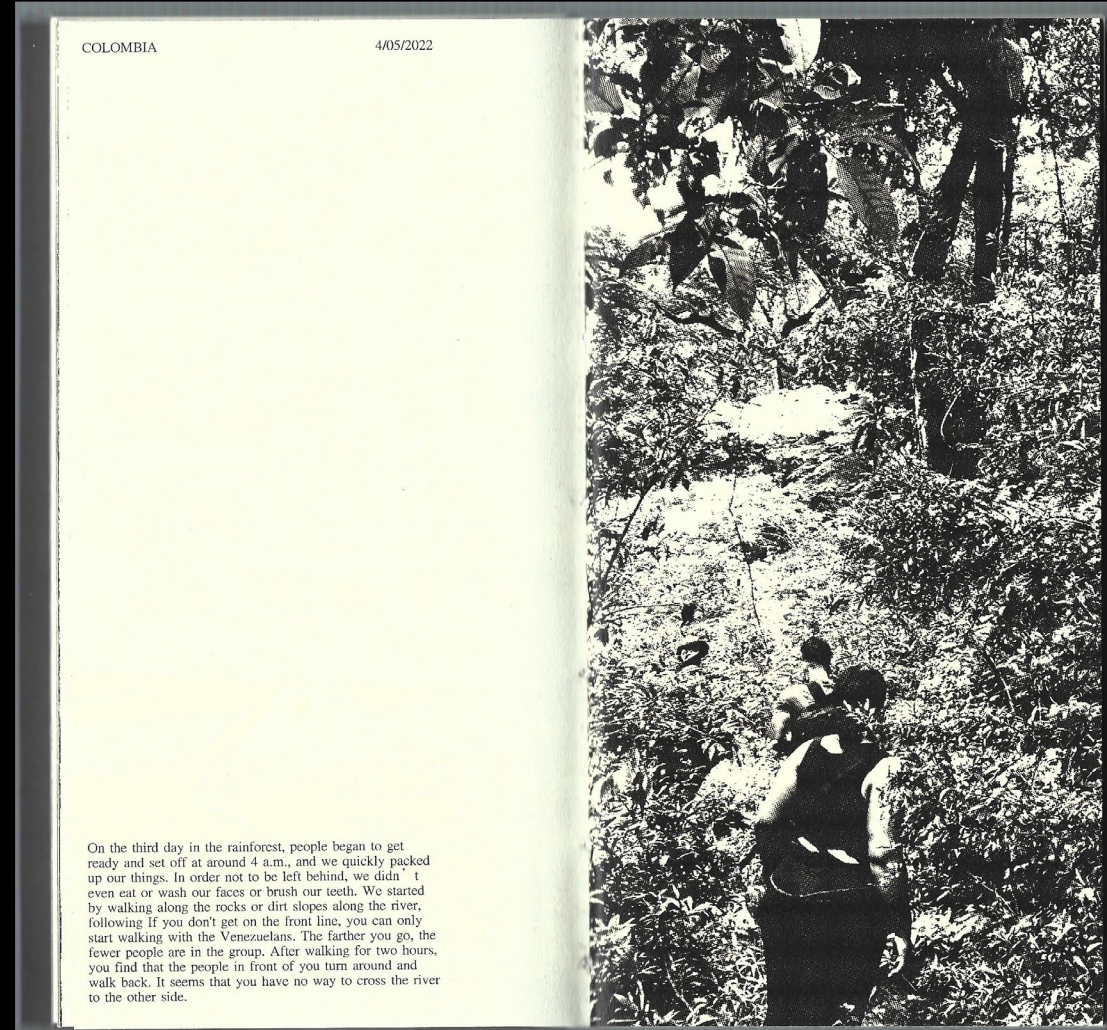
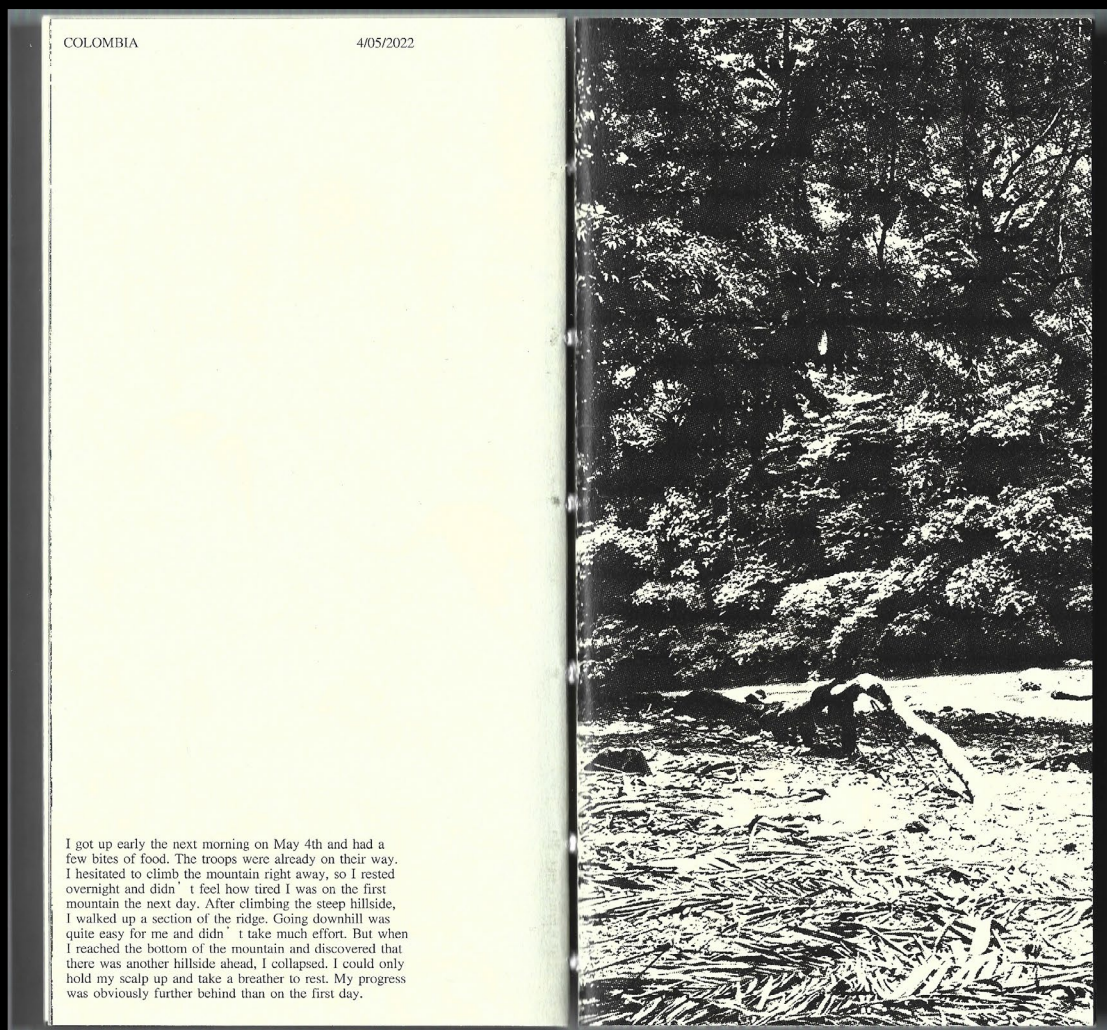
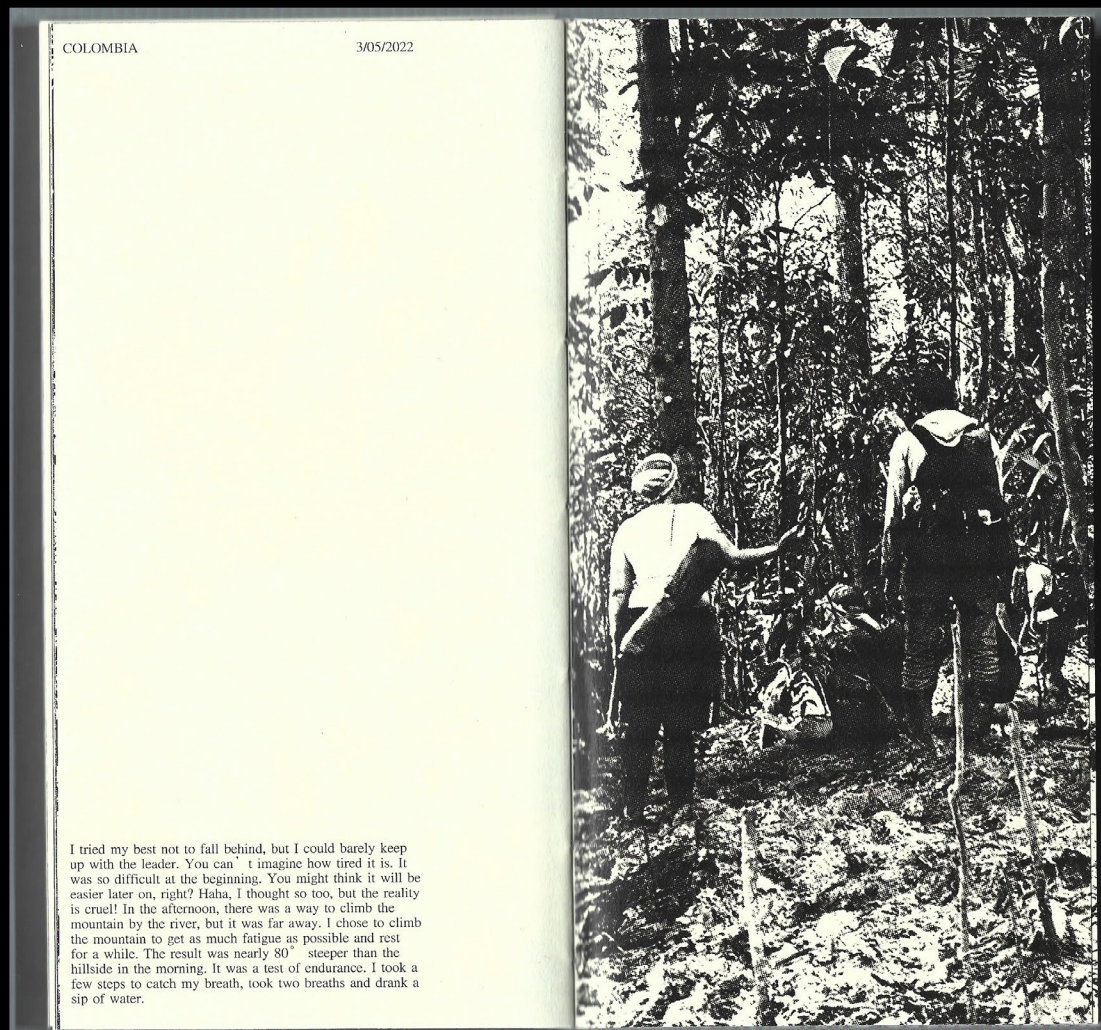
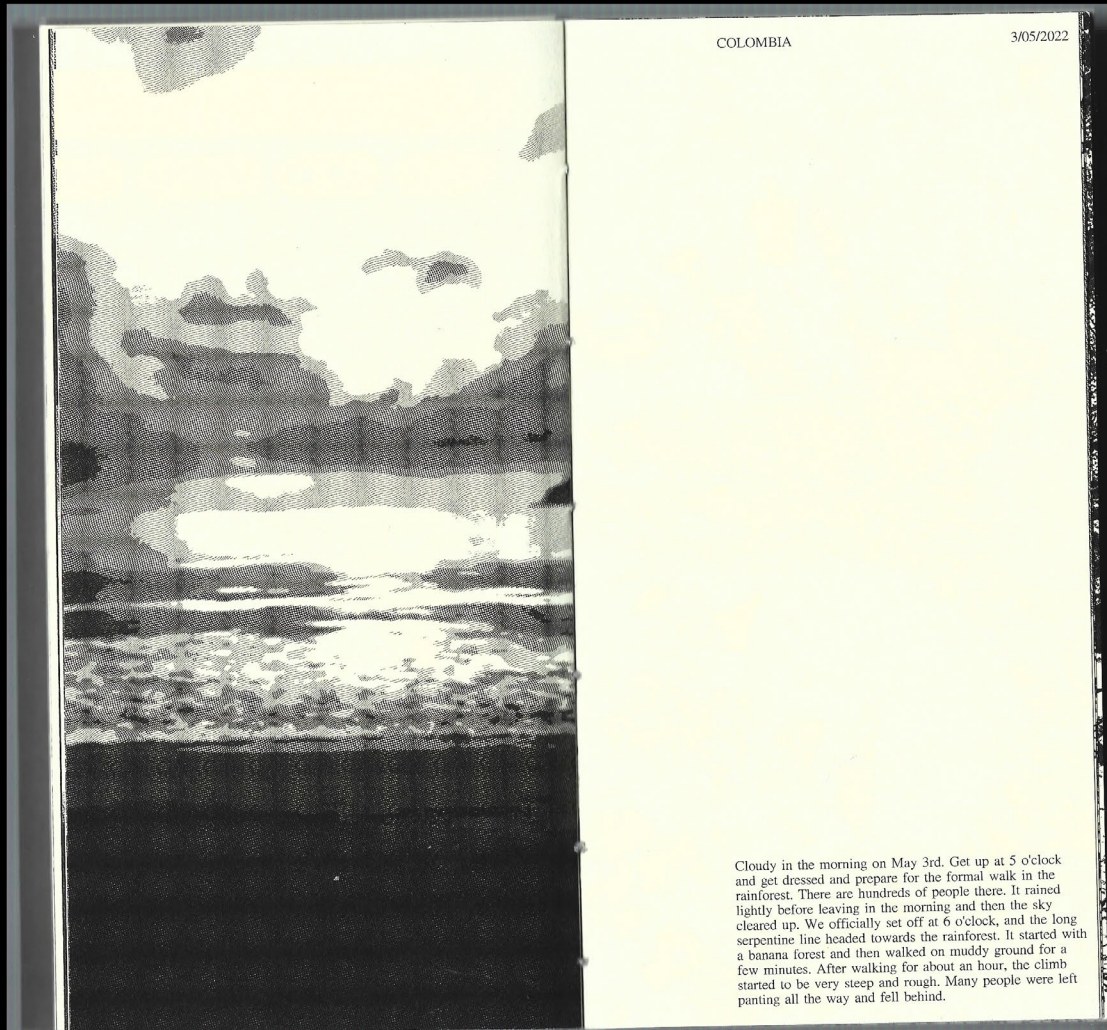
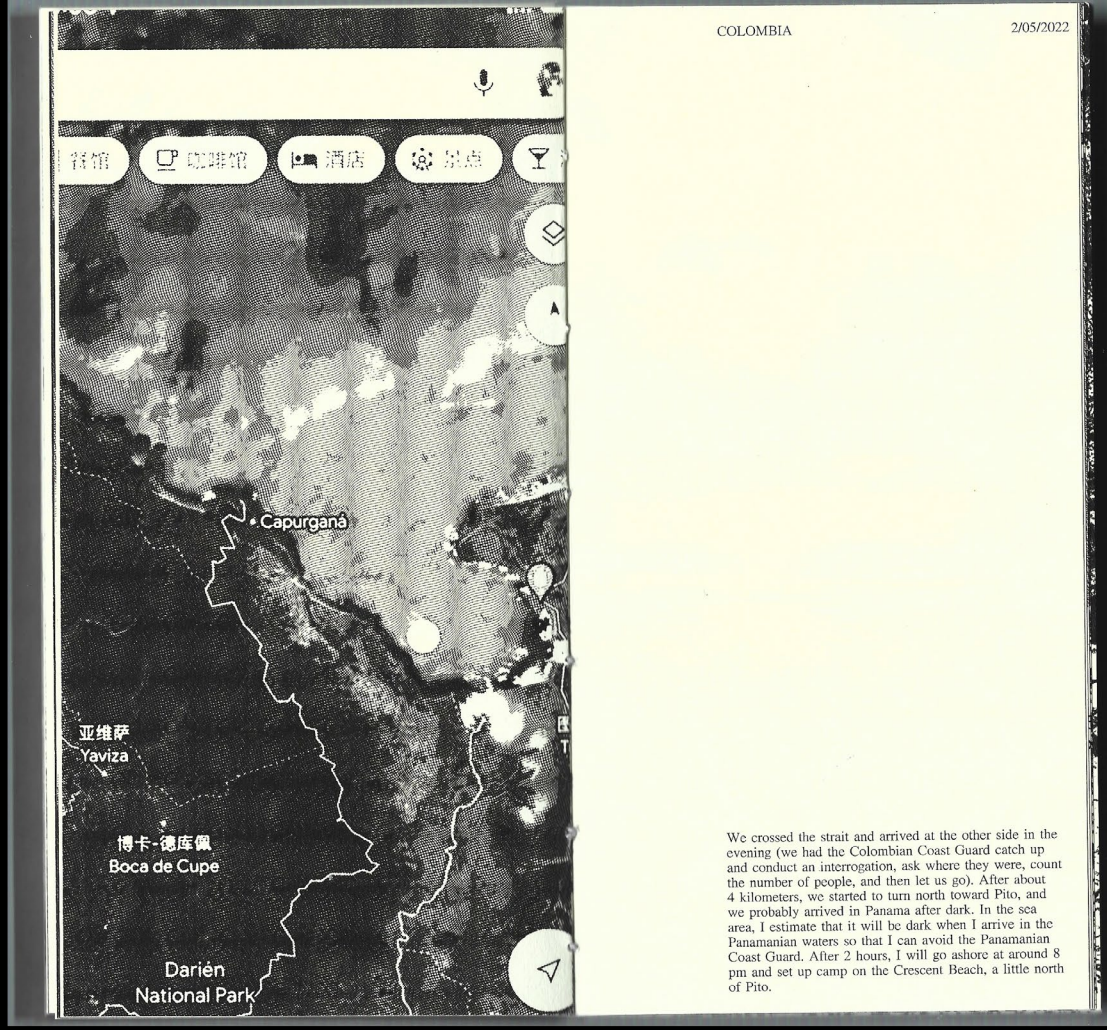
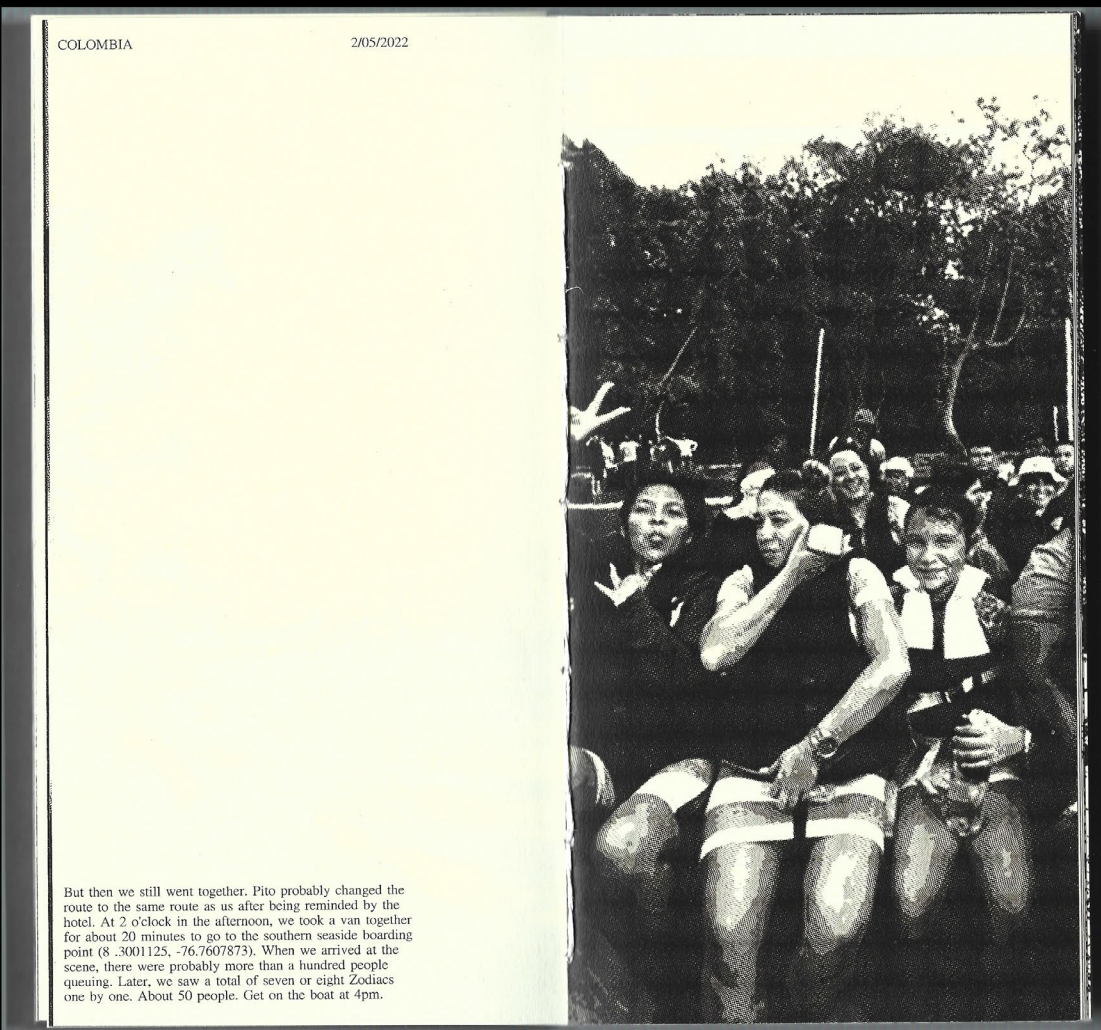
The captain has just informed us that we can't leave today, and we have to stay in bed for a day and set off to the rainforest tomorrow. If we are delayed for a day, we don't have to pay for the room. The hotel here costs \$30 a day without air conditioning and only has a fan, and \$15 a day with air conditioning and a fan. The air conditioner is powered off during the day and powered on at night.

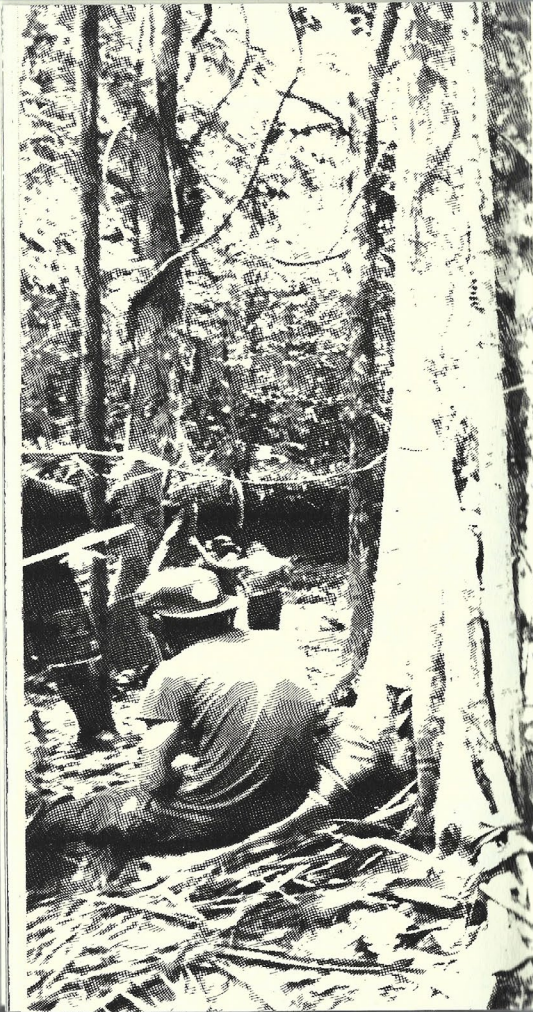


Neco Hotel, don't go to the hotel recommended by the black captain for 15 US dollars. The air conditioner is cut off during the day, and the toilets are not provided. The boss is very stingy and mean. I suggest you go to Casa Hotel. This restaurant in Tucan Caribeño has everything for the same price and is quiet and has a hammock in the kitchen and back garden.



2nd of May local time. After getting up at 10 o'clock, I washed my clothes and went to have lunch at 11 o'clock. After finishing my work, I went straight to the supermarket to purchase supplies for the rainforest for three days. When I came back, I paid 300 knives (the equivalent of the local currency was pesos. The cash machine in Necoclí can only withdraw pesos and UnionPay cannot be used. There are many police officers on the Colombian road who dare not bring more US dollars). When we gathered on the balcony of the hotel, there were about seven or eight Venezuelans together, and asked them if they were going to Pao.

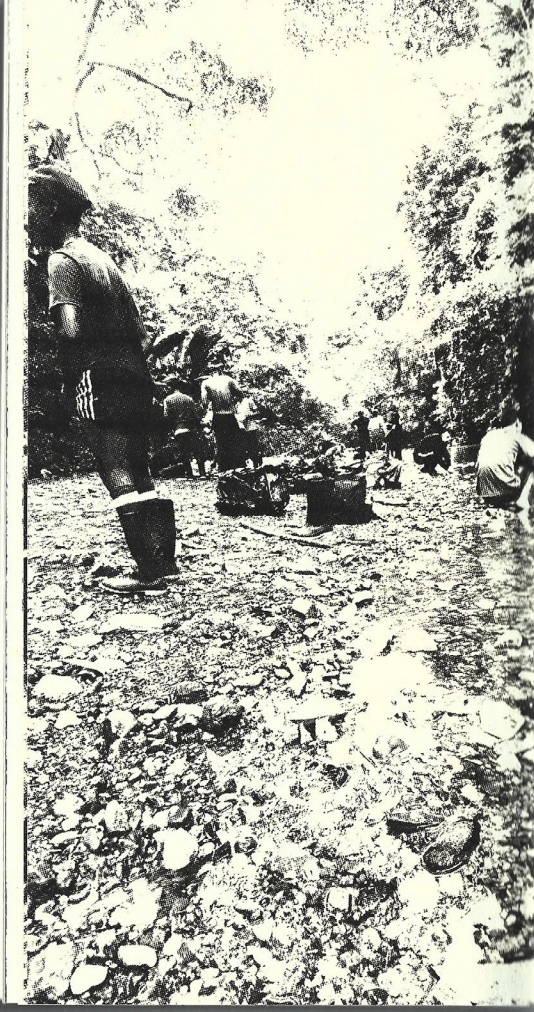




COLOMBIA

Including me, 6 boys and 5 girls, we have been walking back and forth across the river, stopping at most to drink water, and walking non-stop throughout the day. Although I didn't climb a big mountain, the walking was very strenuous and many people walked with a limp when they arrived at the boarding point. Of course that includes me. Around 3 o'clock in the afternoon, two or three groups of people walked together. There were more jungle slopes at this time. I went downhill quickly and got separated from the Venezuelans. After waiting for a while, I couldn't find them.

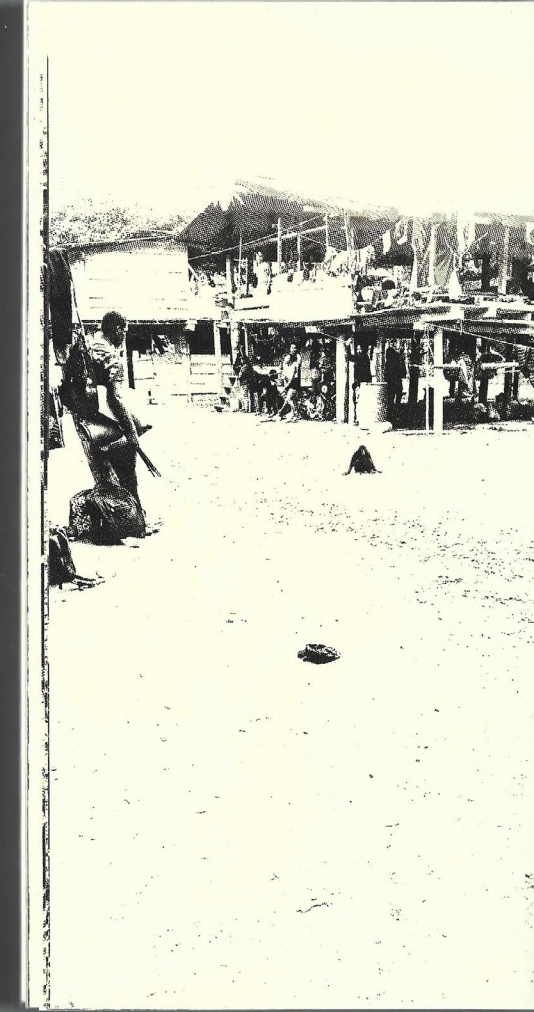
I had no choice but to follow a group of people walking through the jungle. I didn't encounter any clean streams in the process and I was so thirsty that I couldn't bear it. After persisting for a while, I found that I was very hungry again. There were only three small packs of Oreo cookies in the package. I took out 2 packs and put them in my pocket while eating. Get better immediately. When we encountered a big river around 4 o'clock, we ran over to it and climbed down. We just stuck our butts out and drank. After drinking enough water, my teammates started walking again. A fat guy and I couldn't walk anymore, so we sat on the other side to rest and took out the only pack of Oreos.

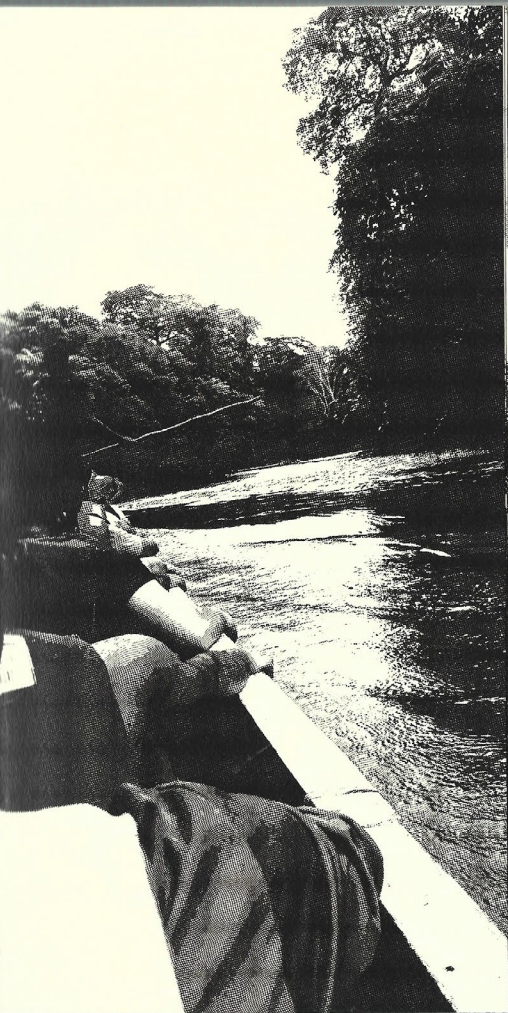
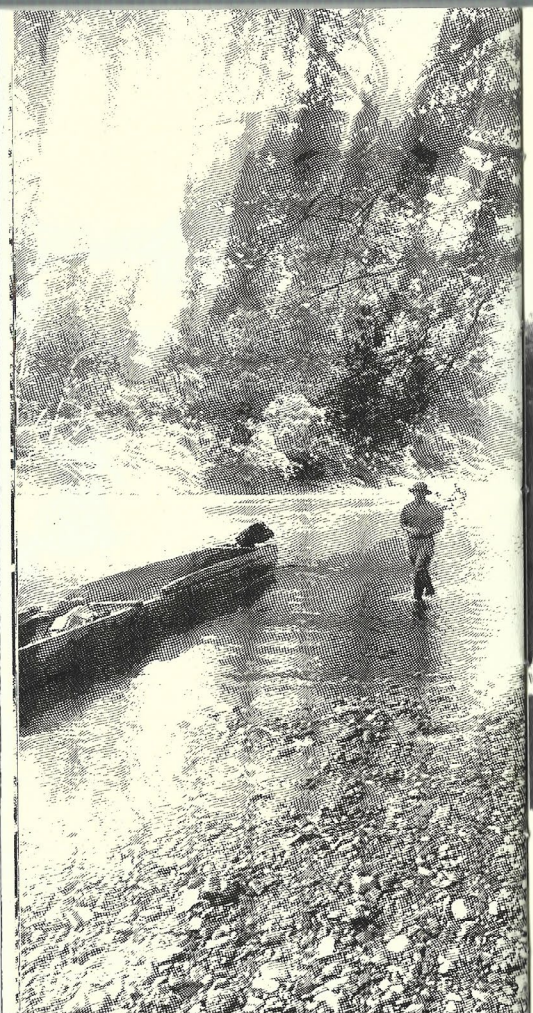
I met two women and a strong man who were alone. One woman was walking with a limp. After asking, I found out that she also had a frayed inner thigh. The fat man walked too fast and was in a hurry to get to the boarding point, so I didn't go with him. After walking slowly with these three people for a while, it was considered a rest. After a while, the strong man left alone, leaving me and the two women walking slowly through the banana forest. The guide came back to urge the three of us, saying that we were right ahead and walked quickly. It was getting dark soon.

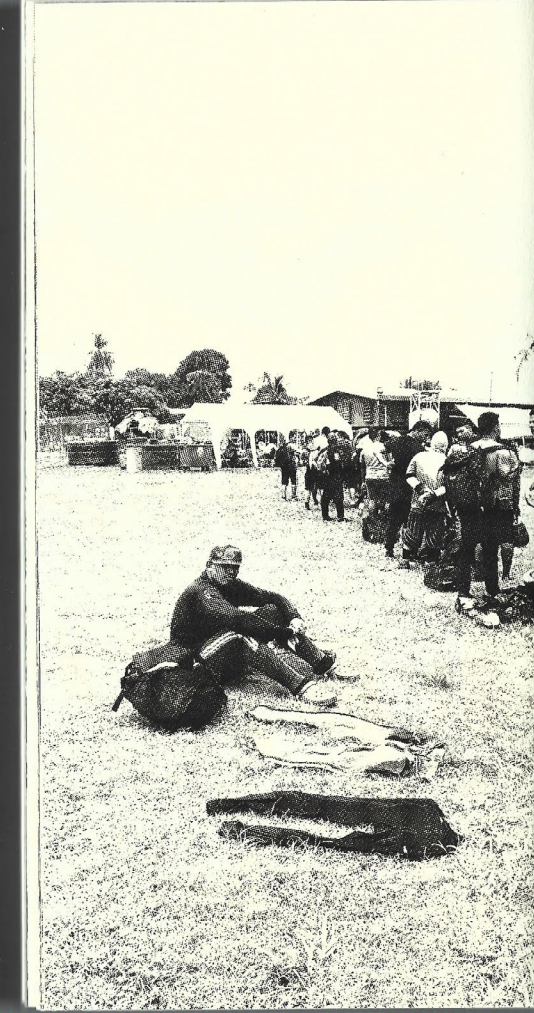
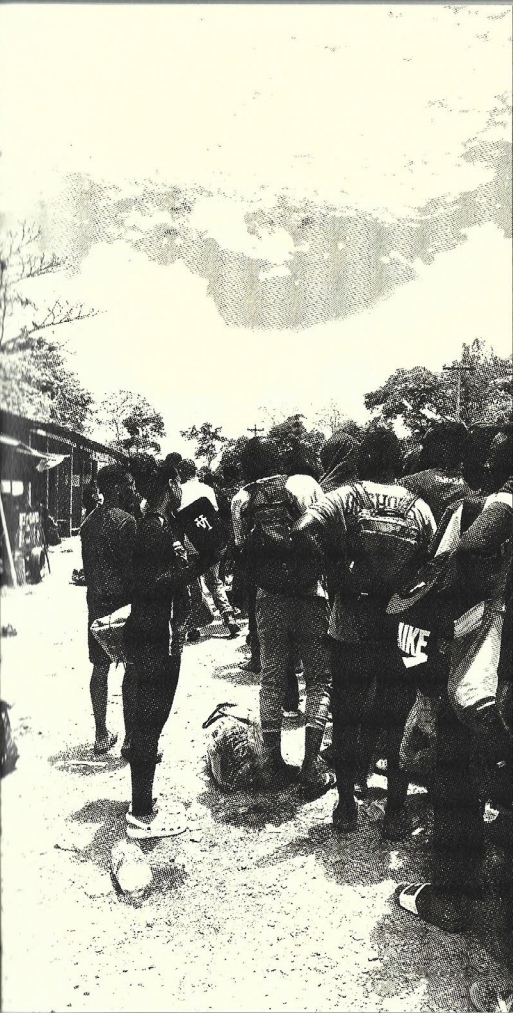
Ignoring the wounds to speed up just about dark to reach the canoe landing point (8.65230, -77.74515) embarkation point there are a lot of wooden buildings barracks and very dirty, pigs, ducks and chickens are free-range. Immediately after arriving to the river to wash, the entire river is muddy at least three days out of the rainforest. After washing to go to the first floor to eat. 5 yuan chicken rice. 1 yuan cola dry full. And sell cigarettes for 5 yuan a packet, three days of rainforest smoke finally smoked.

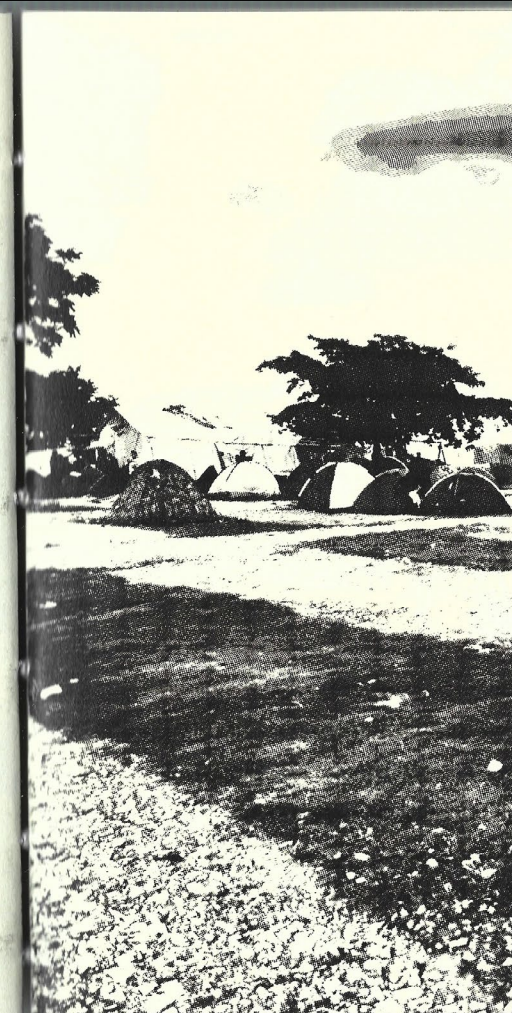
On May 6th, I slept in a tent overnight and queued up to board a canoe at 8 am. It cost 2\$ per person. This canoe was very dangerous and almost capsized halfway through. Most of the water came in and I kept bailing out the water. It took about an hour by canoe to reach the refugee point downstream. After arriving at the refugee point (8.6551400, -77.8071000), I had to queue up to register a copy of my passport information. I also had to search my body and bag. My ballpoint pens, lighters, cigarettes and nail clippers had to be confiscated. They kept asking me if I had any money.

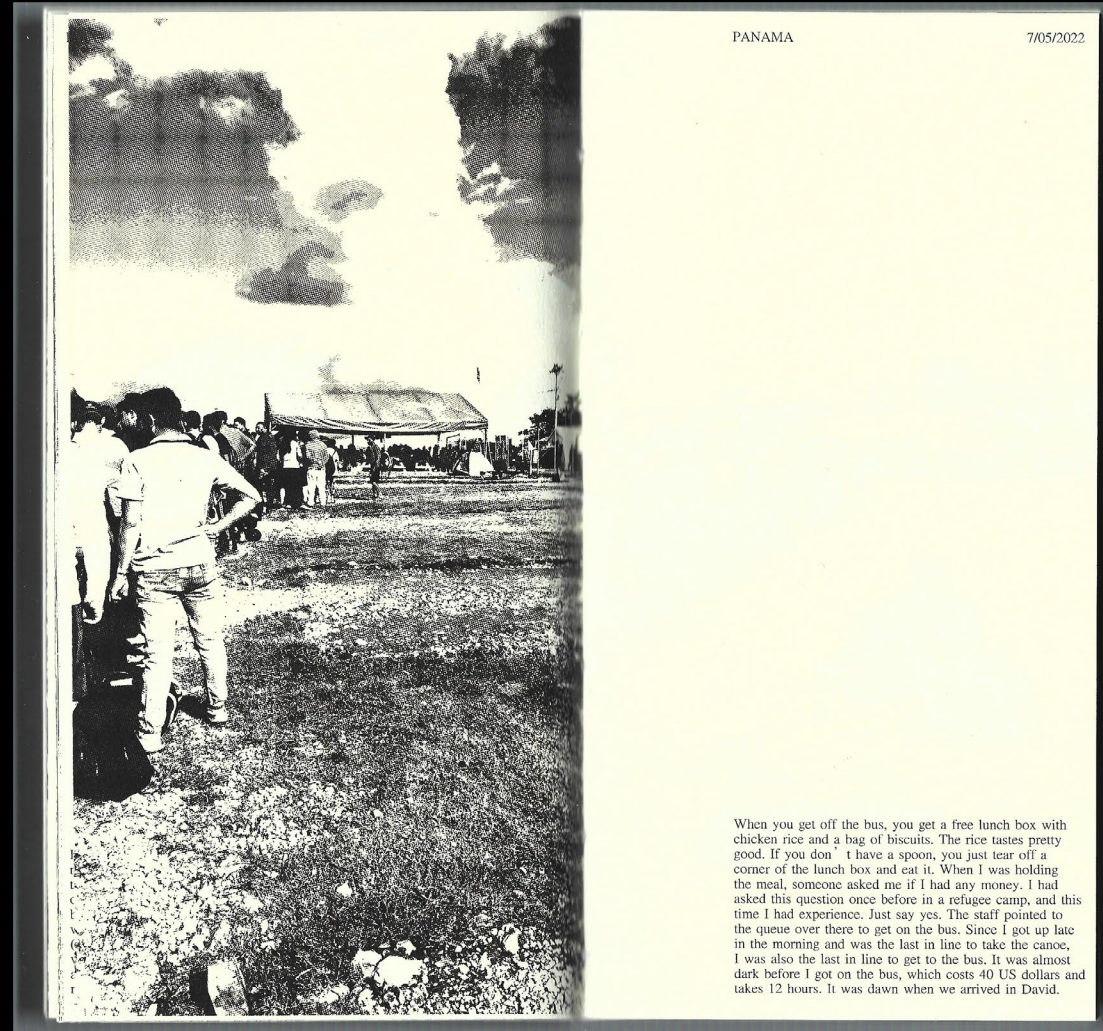

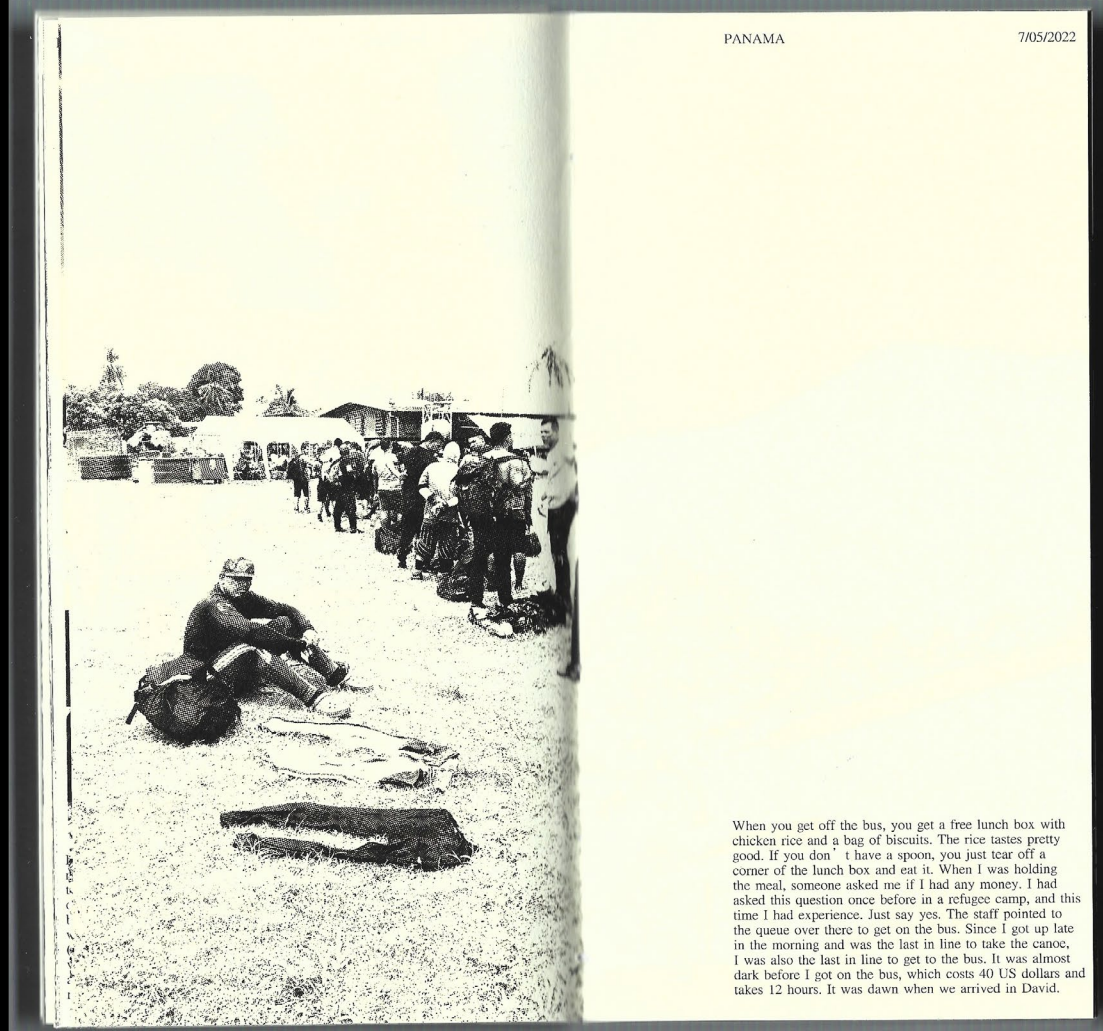

I woke up at 6 o'clock on May 7th and found that there was no one in the square. Damn it, I had to go to the square to queue up to board the canoe at 8 o'clock. There was no one left at the end of the queue. This time, the canoe can be used in double rows and is tall and safe. After 4 hours, we arrived at the downstream military vehicle pulling point (8.5444015, -77.8951263). There were about four military vehicles, and each vehicle came back and forth about once an hour. After taking a military vehicle to the refugee camp next to the road (8.5606184, -78.0212230).

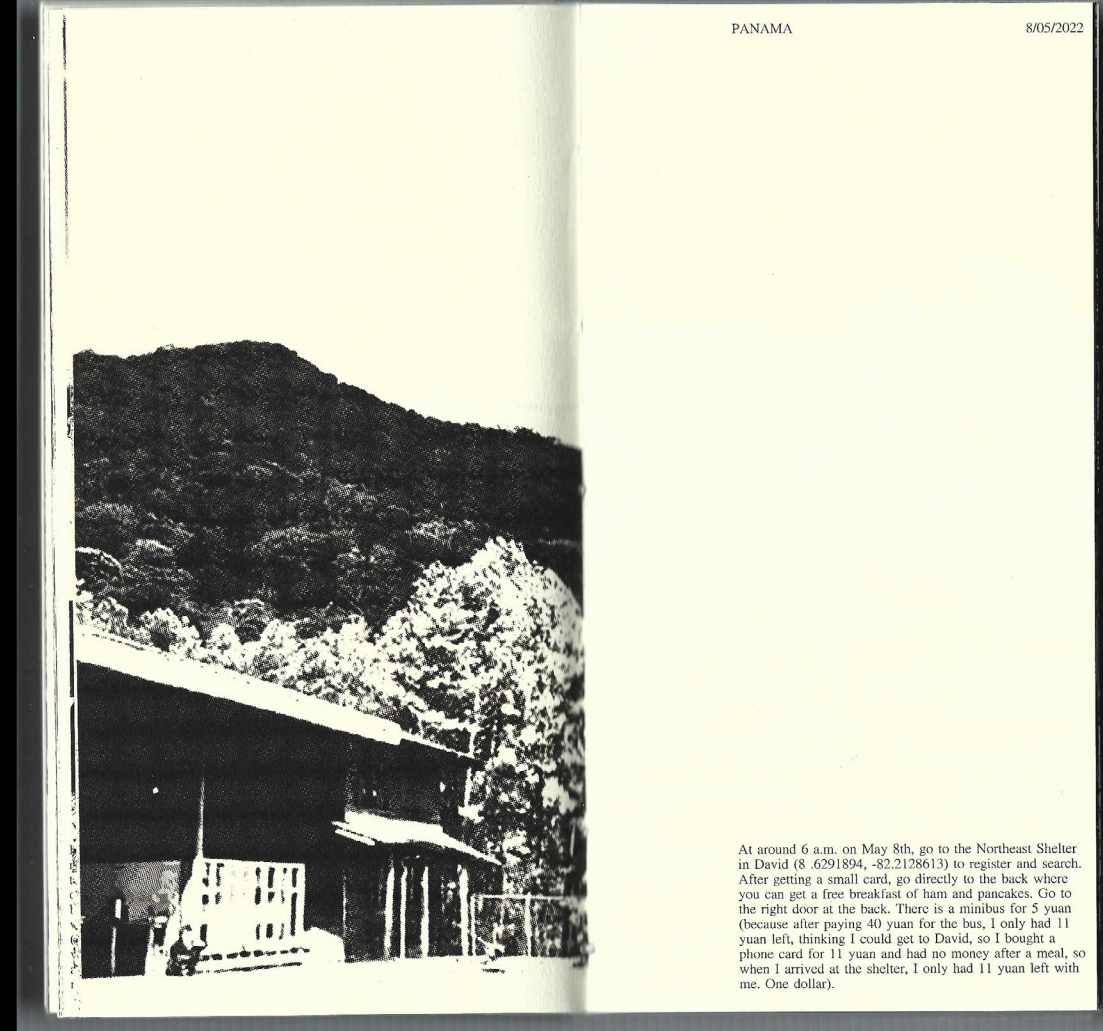




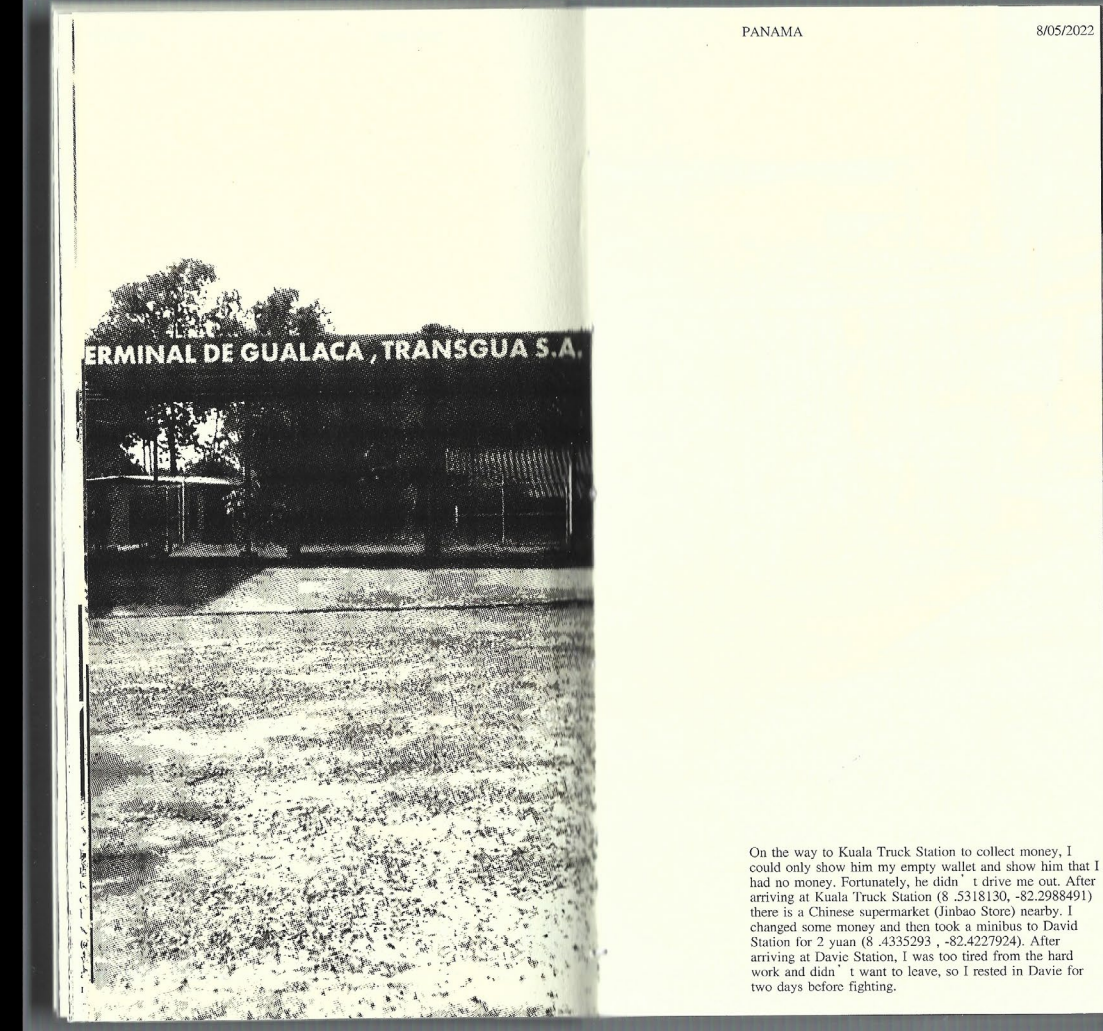
When you get off the bus, you get a free lunch box with chicken rice and a bag of biscuits. The rice tastes pretty good. If you don't have a spoon, you just tear off a corner of the lunch box and eat it. When I was holding the meal, someone asked me if I had any money. I had asked this question once before in a refugee camp, and this time I had experience. Just say yes. The staff pointed to the queue over there to get on the bus. Since I got up late in the morning and was the last in line to take the canoe, I was also the last in line to get to the bus. It was almost dark before I got on the bus, which costs 40 US dollars and takes 12 hours. It was dawn when we arrived in David.



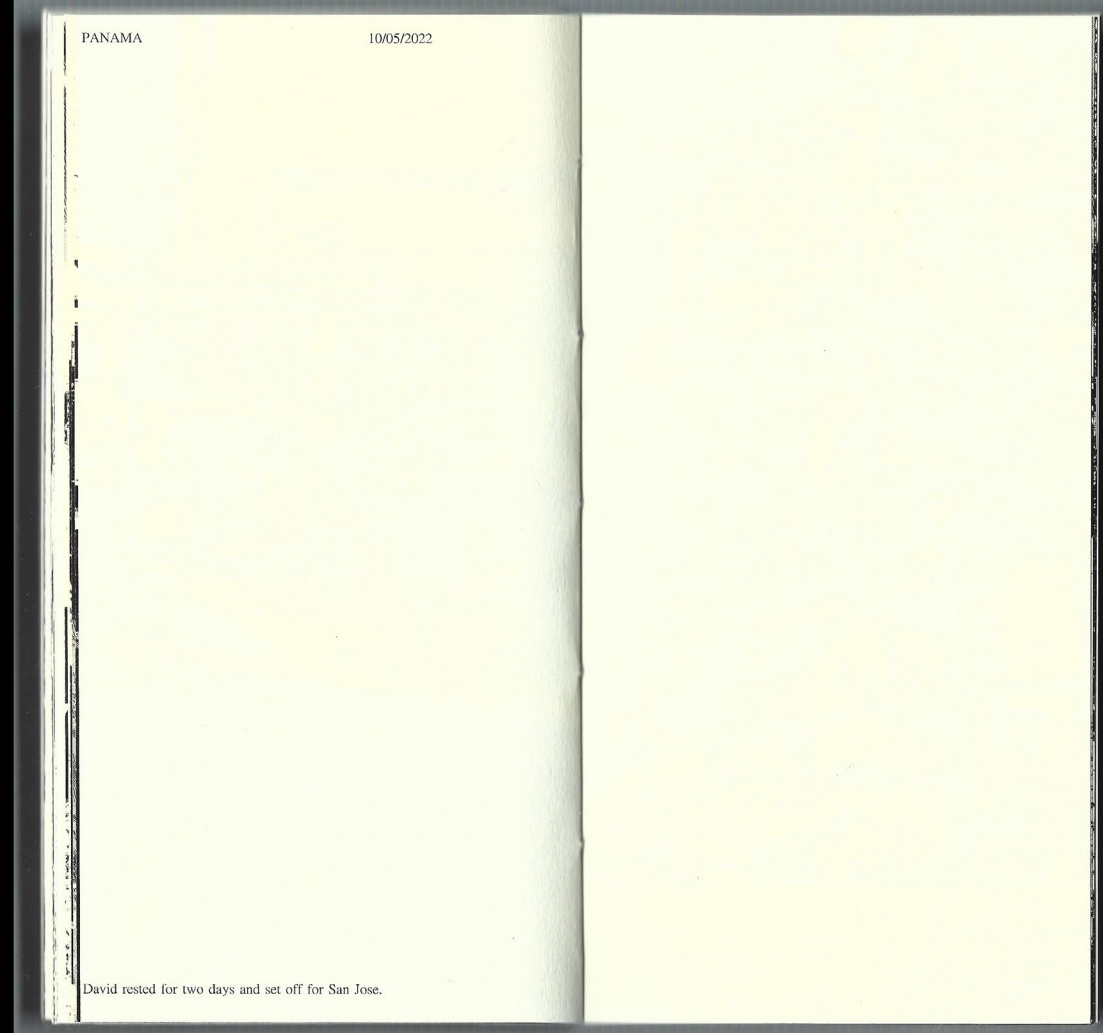
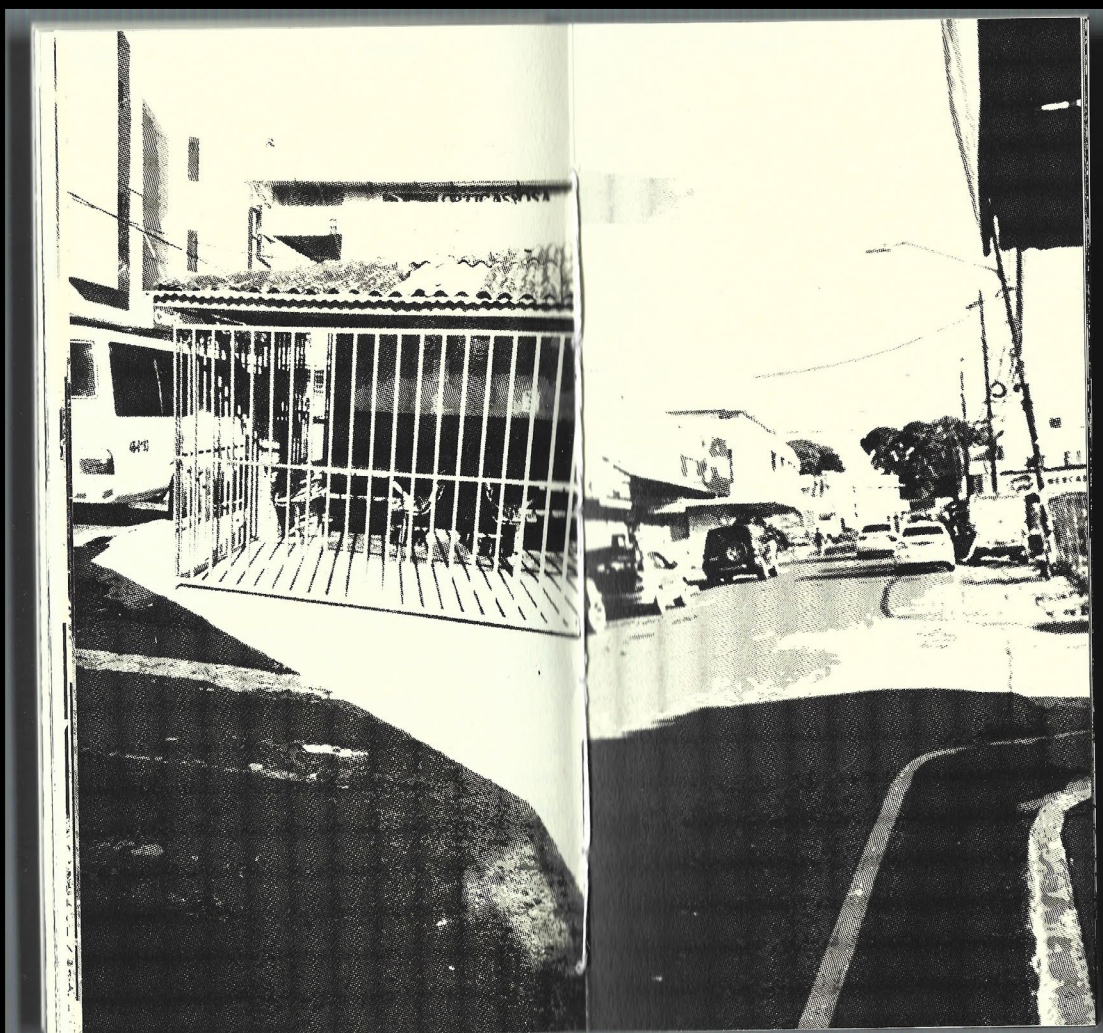
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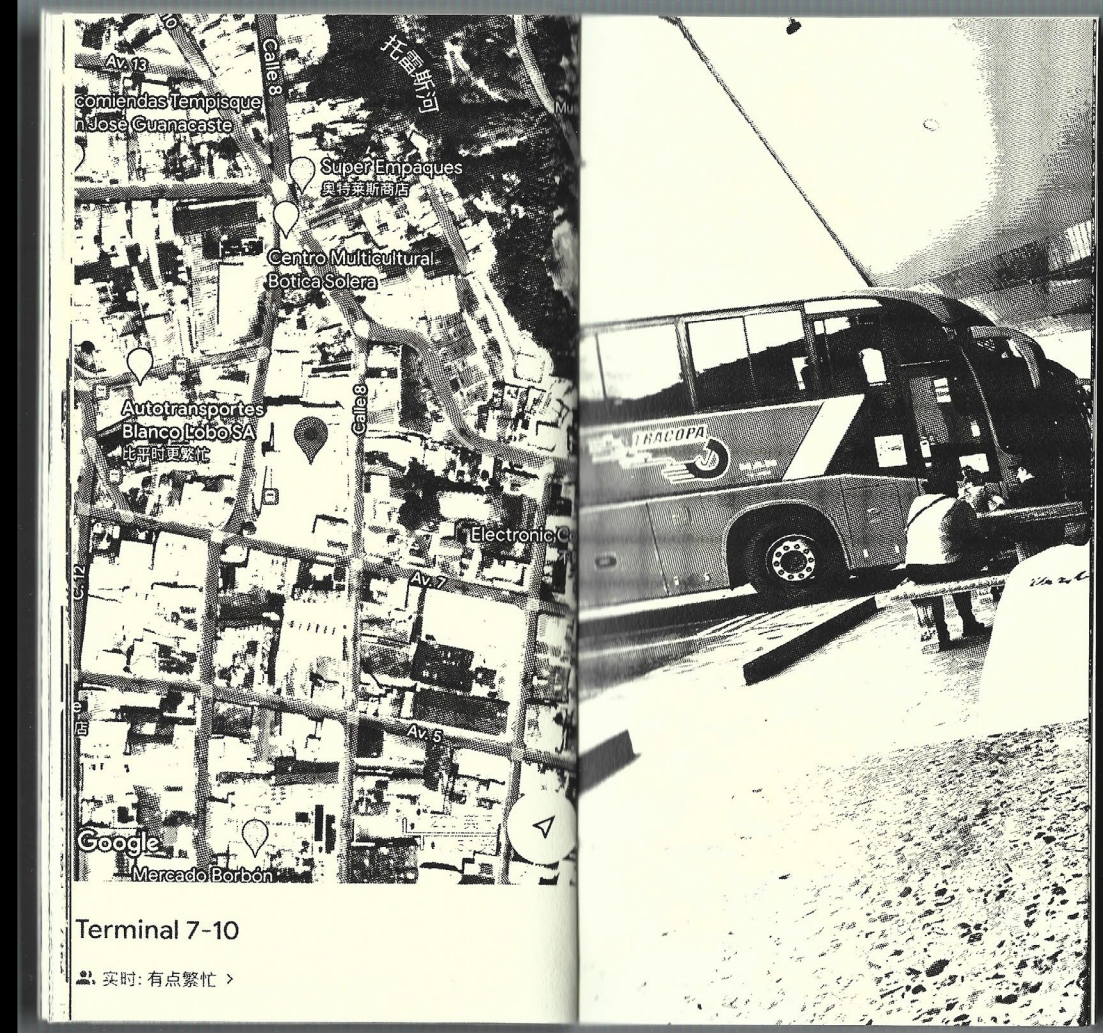
At around 6 a.m. on May 8th, go to the Northeast Shelter in David (8 6291894, -82.2129613) to register and search. After getting a small card, go directly to the back where you can get a free breakfast of ham and pancakes. Go to the right door at the back. There is a minibus for 5 yuan (because after paying 40 yuan for the bus, I only had 11 yuan left, thinking I could get to David, so I bought a phone card for 11 yuan and had no money after a meal, so when I arrived at the shelter, I only had 11 yuan left with me. One dollar).



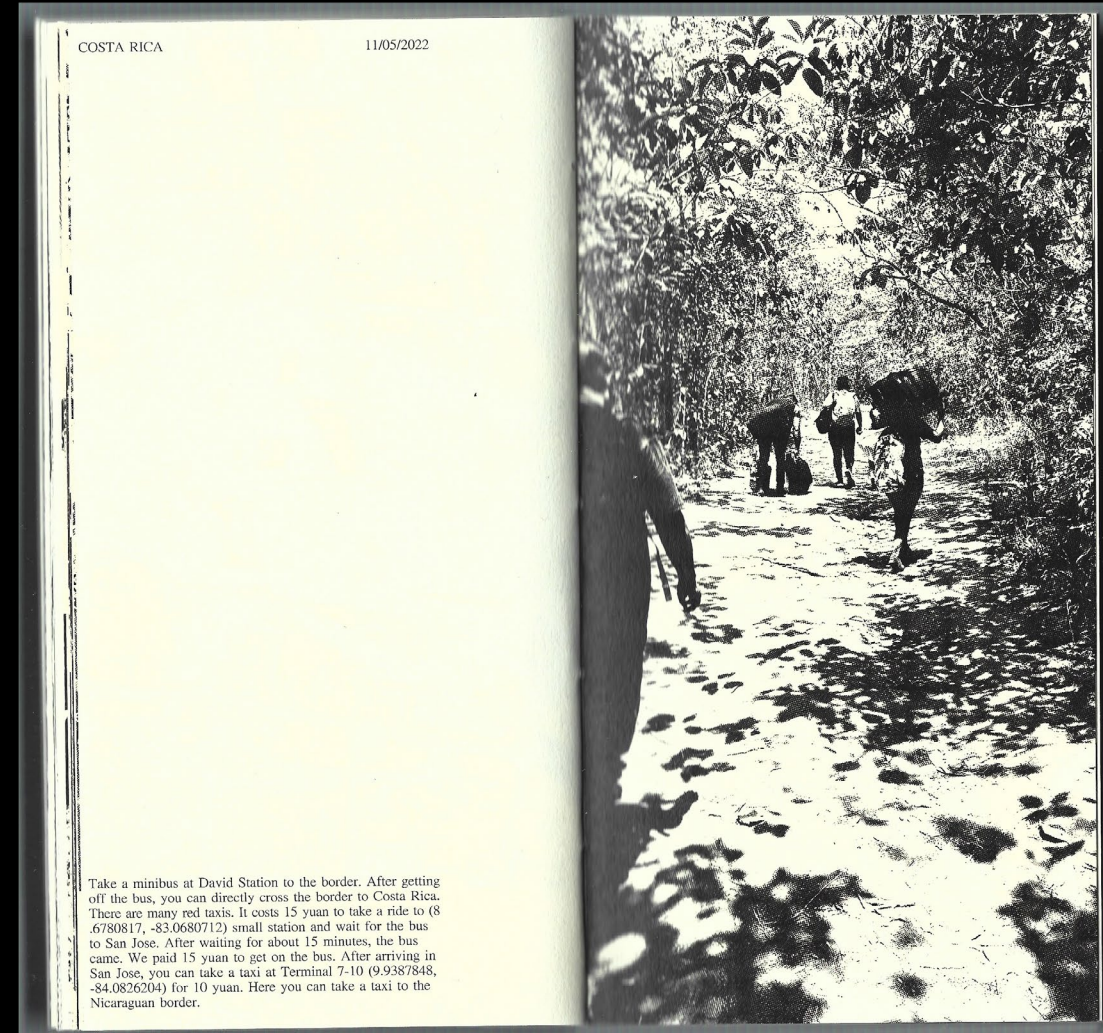
On the way to Kuala Truck Station to collect money, I could only show him my empty wallet and show him that I had no money. Fortunately, he didn't drive me out. After arriving at Kuala Truck Station (8 -2318130, -82.298491) there is a Chinese supermarket (Jinhao Store) nearby. I changed some money and then took a minibus to David Station for 2 yuan (8 -4335293, -82.4227924). After arriving at David Station, I was too tired from the hard work and didn't want to leave, so I rested in David for two days before fighting.



David rested for two days and set off for San Jose.

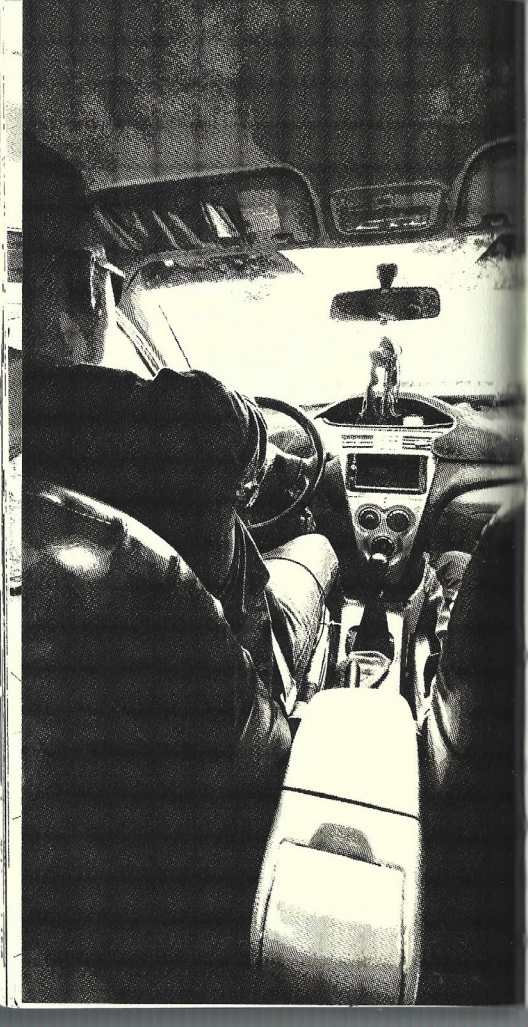
Take a minibus at David Station to the border. After getting off the bus, you can directly cross the border to Costa Rica. There are many red taxis. It costs 15 yuan to take a ride to (8 2788917, -82.0680712) small station and wait for the bus to San Jose. After waiting for about 15 minutes, the bus came. We paid 15 yuan to get on the bus. After arriving in San Jose, you can take a taxi at Terminal 7-10 (9-9387848, -84.0826204) for 10 yuan. Here you can take a taxi to the Nicaraguan border.



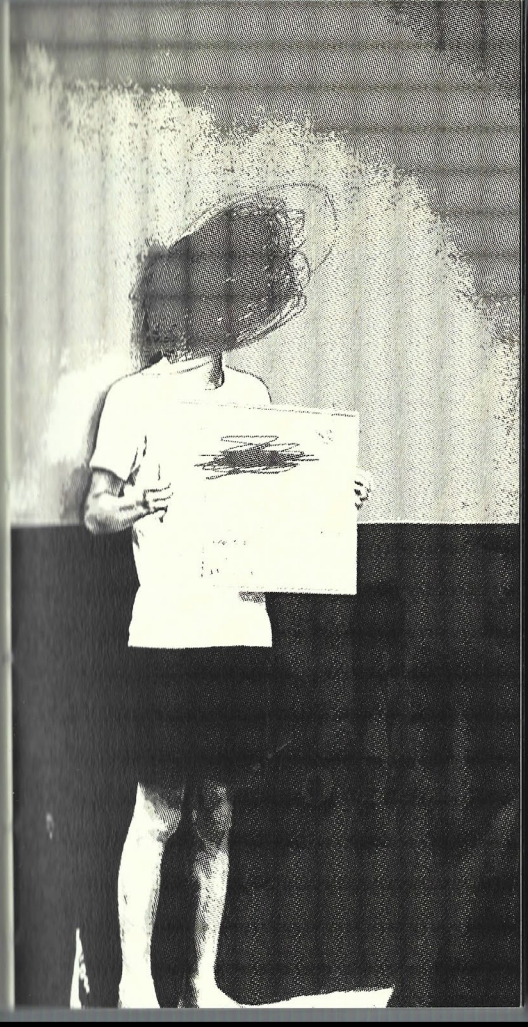
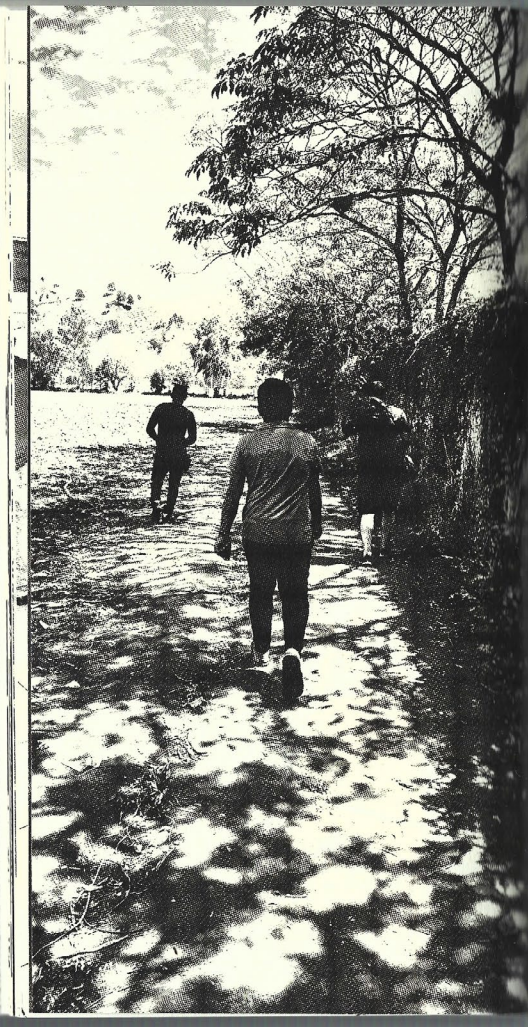
At 4:30am local time on May 11th in San Jose, go to Terminal 7-10 station and catch the first bus to the Nicaraguan border (1.0733737, -84.6971504) and arrive at 11am. After getting off the bus, we followed the team and walked along the dirt road along the border wall for more than ten minutes. After walking along the dirt road, we saw the concrete road and then turned right for a few hundred meters to the Immigration Bureau (11.0766485, -84.6956122) to go through immigration procedures (USD 150).



It took 3 hours to queue up. After checking in, the staff will make you to take a black car for \$3 to the San Carlos stop and take a bus to Lake Managua. Since you arrived at 2pm, you saw that the bus was already full of people. There are no seats left. We chose to spend the night in San Carlos.



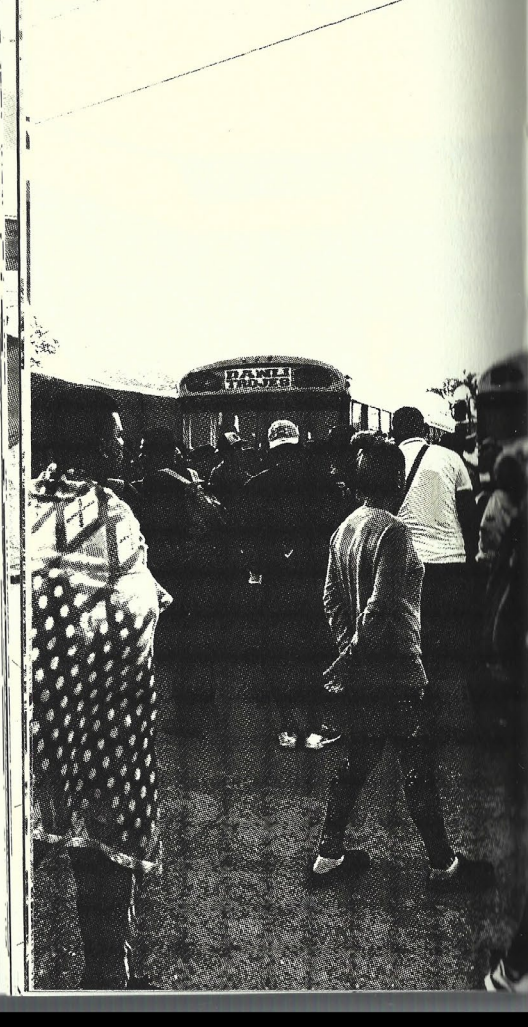
Point San Carlos (11.1286107, -84.7764486) stop sign and wait for a car to Managua Lake Managua, the supermarket boss said eight o'clock car, but we waited a little anxious and too far to go around the capital, so the taxi to Escazu, an average of 40 knives per person to share down acceptable. At 2:00 pm to Escazu (13.0813398, -86.332517) directly to change the bus 60 local currency to Ocotral (13.6219869, -86.4766677) overnight, tomorrow crossing the border with Honduras.



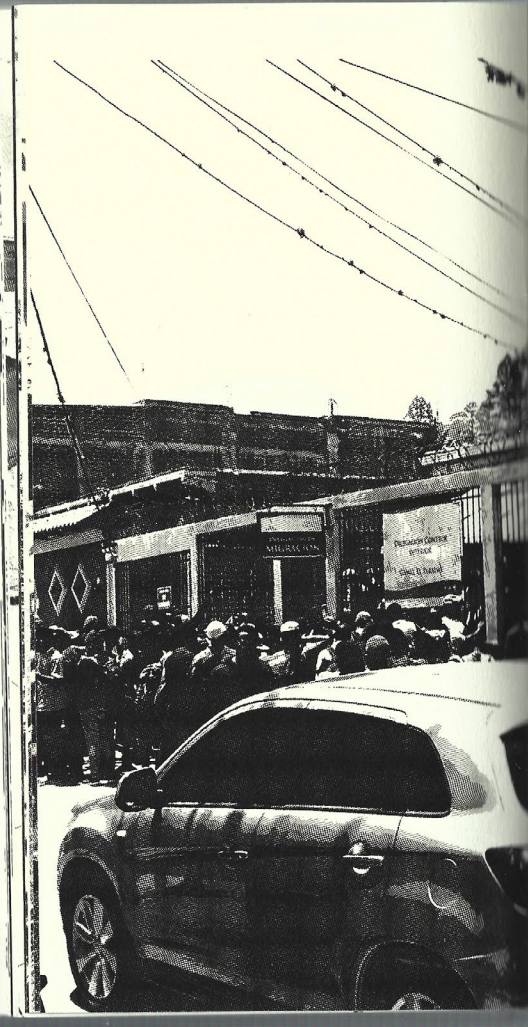
Arrive at Ocotral Station at around 6 a.m. local time on the 13th. There is a bus to Jalapa for 60 local currency. Collect money on the bus. Get off at Jalapa (13.9214806, -86.1268337) and take a taxi directly to the Honduras border for 10 US dollars. Get off the taxi at (14.0768180, -86.0272840) and a tricycle driver will take you across the border. Take his tricycle for \$3 to Trojes. After getting off the tricycle, walk two steps to the information registration office.



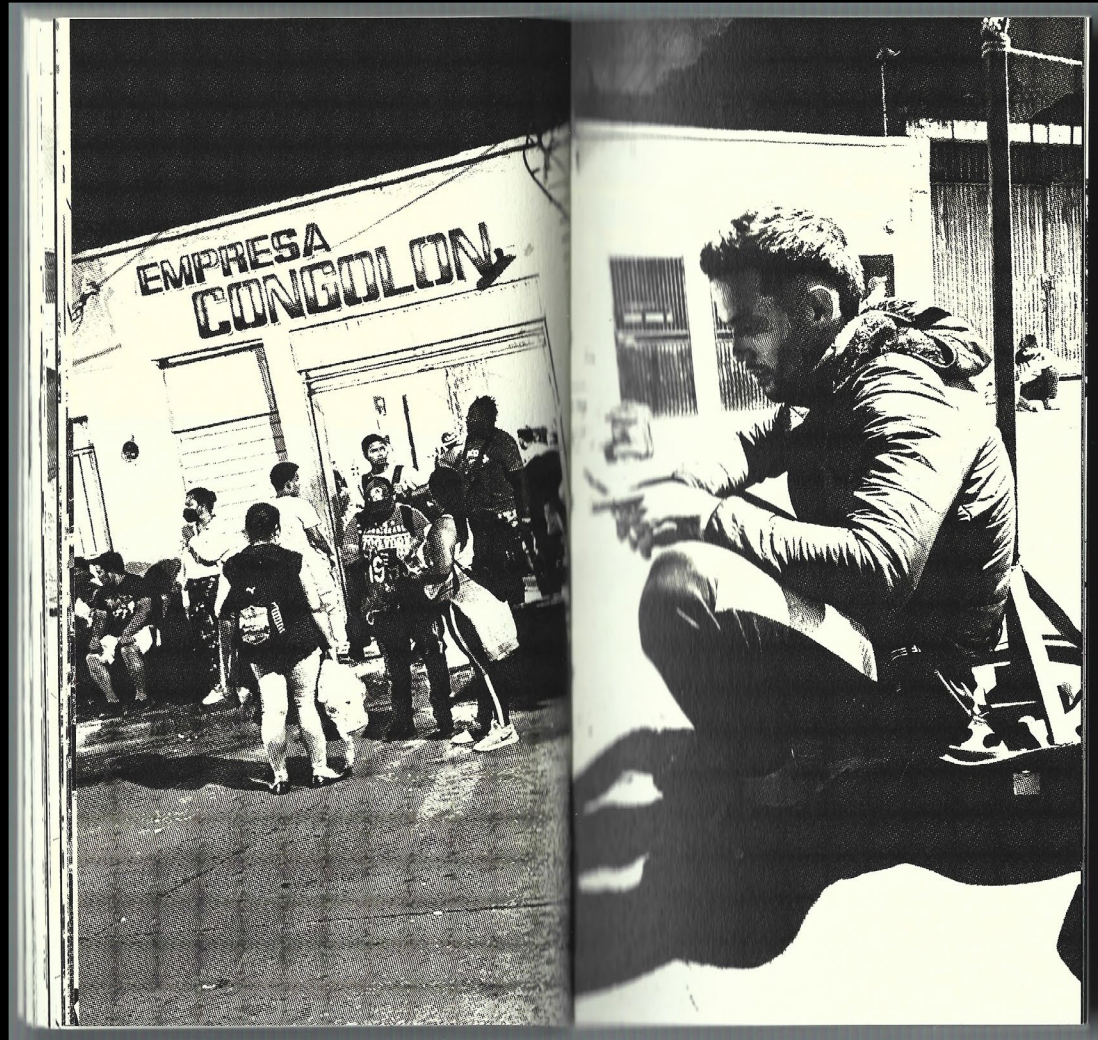
The most important information is here! After arriving at the information registration office (14.0821221, -85.9955334), go directly into the house and go to the backyard pool to register and hand in your passport. It is best to hand in an A4 copy. Then you queue up in the yard to have your fingerprints, pupils, and other information recorded. After the recording is completed, you have to queue up to take a picture with a writing board. Your information will be written on the writing board. Afterwards, I had to take a photo with two armed policemen, which was like the process of going to jail (of course I knew this from watching the movie).



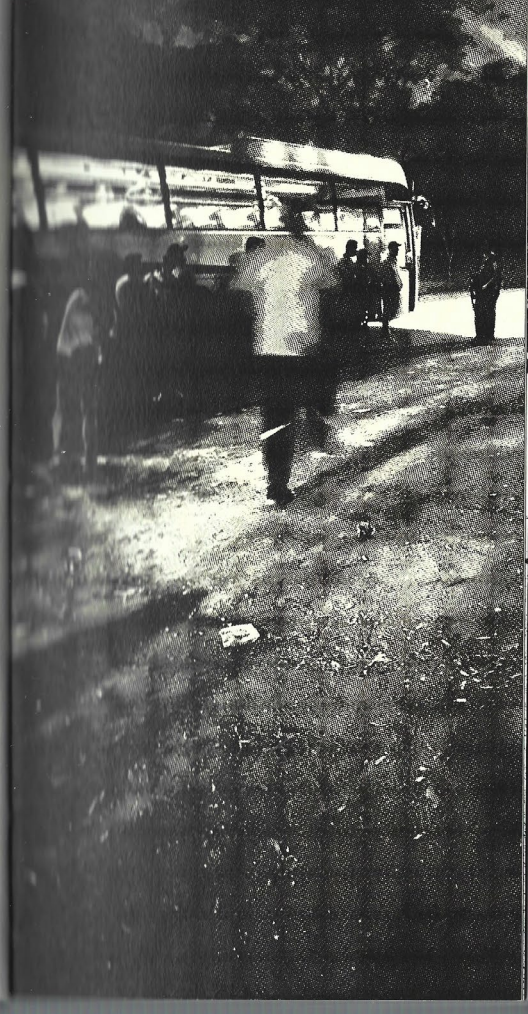
After finishing these things, at 15:00, when everything is done, the clerk will announce a message. Arrive at 5 o'clock tomorrow morning (14.0824207, -85.9968805) at the Citizen Information Registration Office and wait for the bus. The staff will take your passport. Call your name and get on the bus. The \$6 will be sent to Daniil. You should understand now, right? You don't need to pay the \$210, and you can still legally cross Honduras. That's right, I accidentally jumped into the Pauper Refugee Team, and I planned to pay the \$210 before I came. Save on toilet!



The Entry Registration Office in Honduras is a liar. After a lot of manipulation, it took 210 to get to Daniil. Okay, let's go. However, the bank transfer was not open on the weekend, and I couldn't give away the money. I had to wait for Mr. Monday. Sleep scolding and open the way immediately. Take the bus from Daniil here (14.0276586, -86.5879744). There is a stop sign here. Wait for a while and then a yellow bus will come. You don't need to ask for a stamp when you get out. Get off here (14.0282427, -86.5790587).

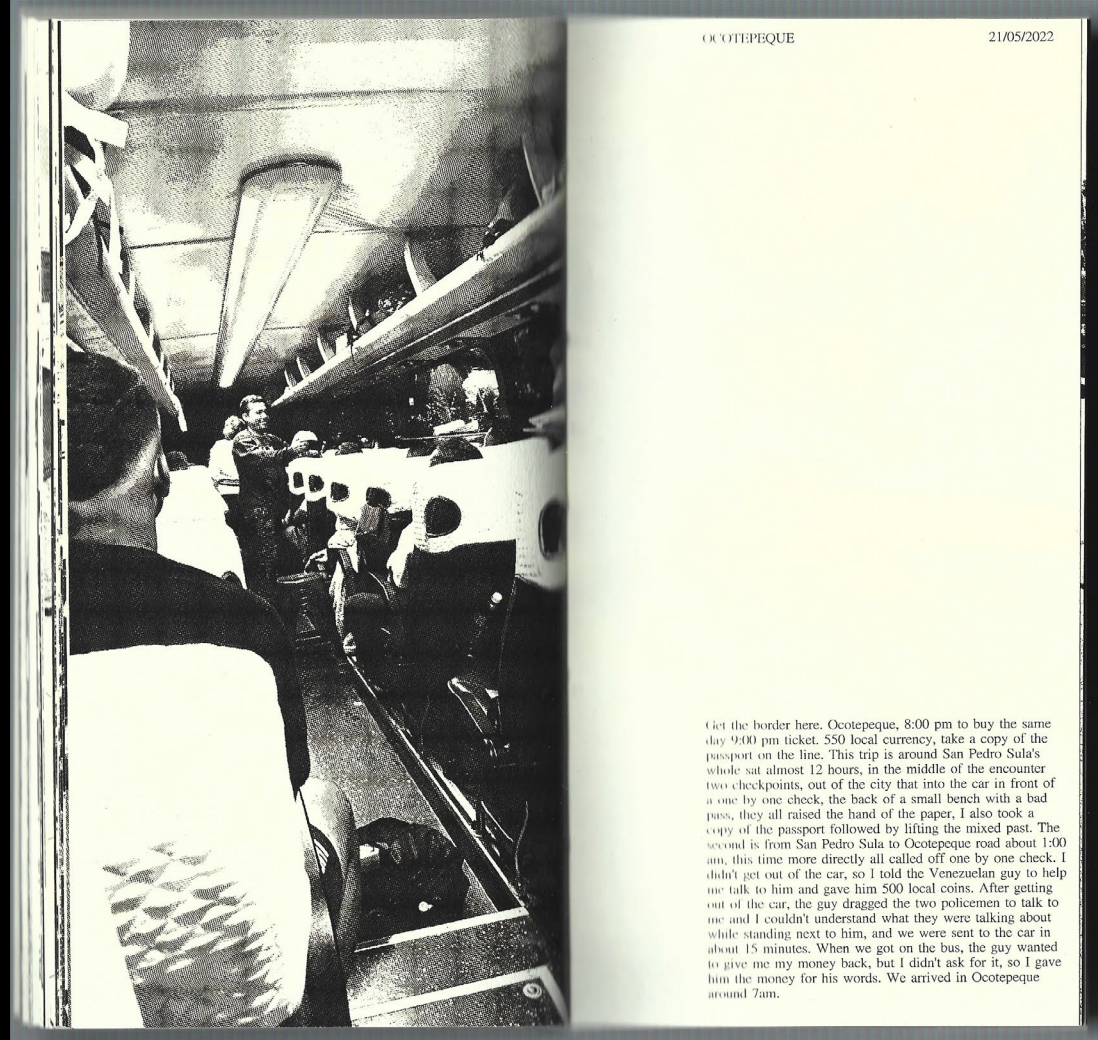

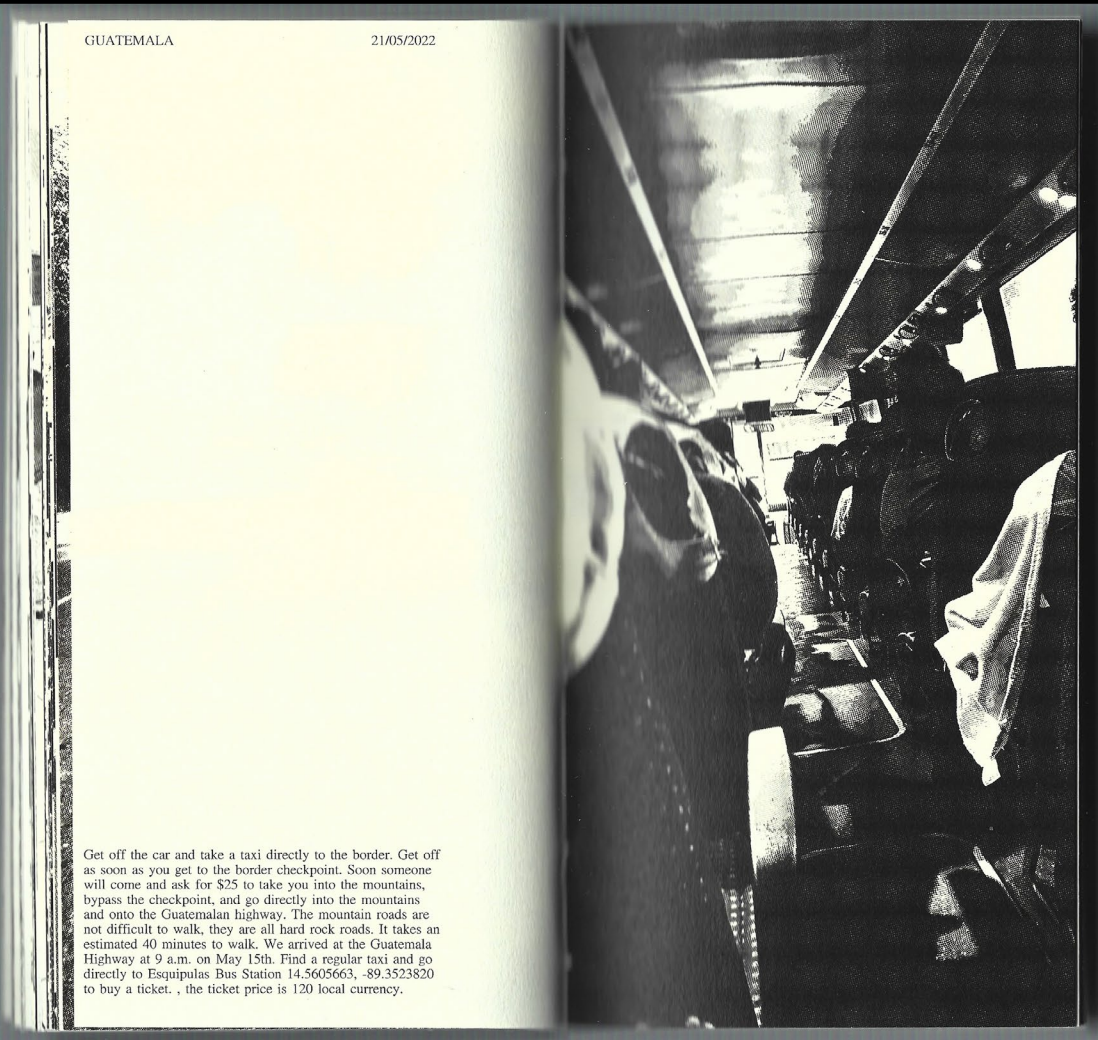
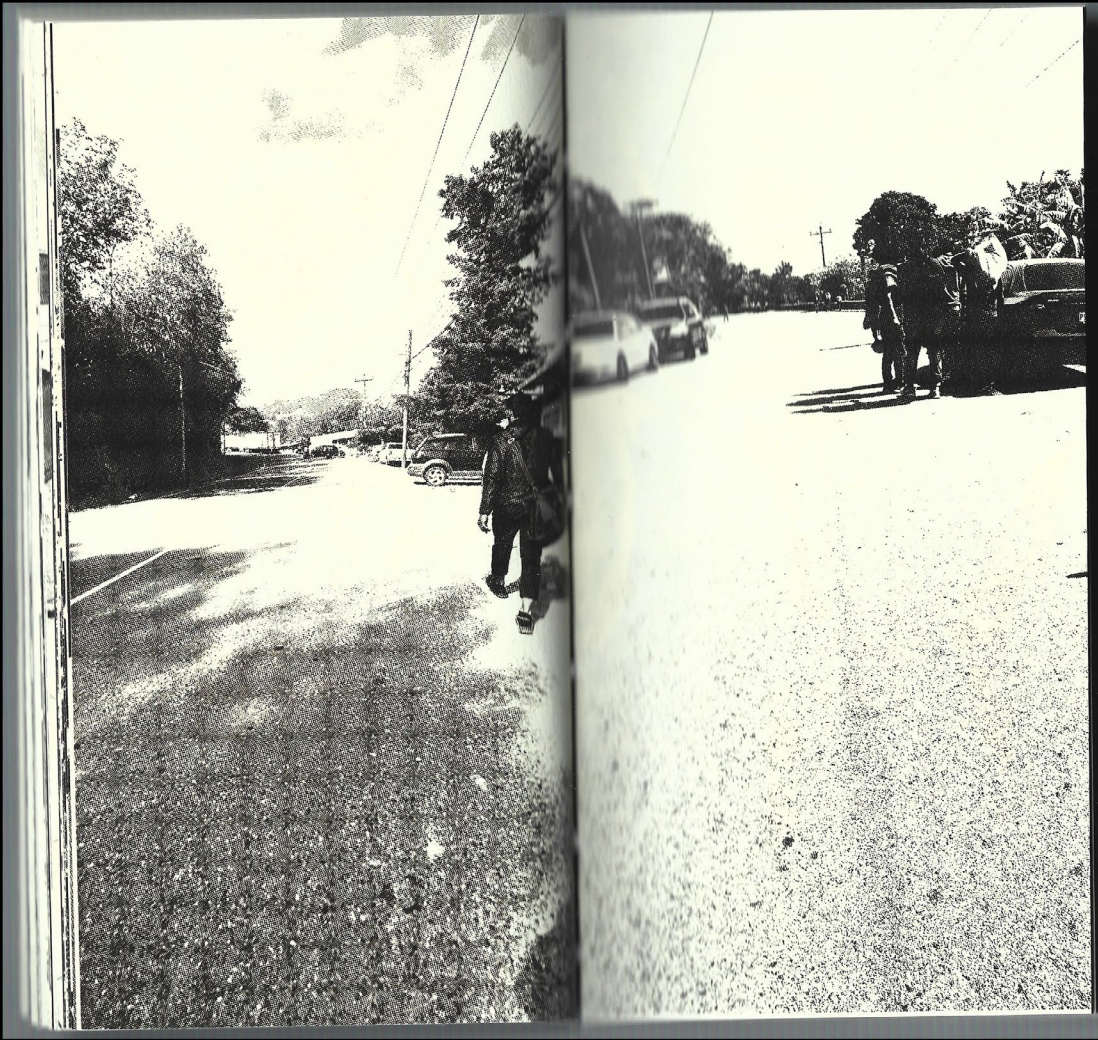
After getting off the bus there are many to Tegucigalpa Tegucigalpa buses, waiting at the intersection, generally here will be under the people, ride under the people hurry up. I was lucky to sit on the side of the road and wait for the car. I thought that this and refused to carry who knows even step and do not stop, is cursing the addiction, suddenly stopped 10 metres away from me, but also open the door, which does not mean that I went up, decisively jogging on the car, get in the car driver and the "conductor" and I immediately greeted warmly, chat for a while before I understood that the conductor sitting in the passenger seat is a walk together in the rainforest, and the driver is a good person.

The driver and the "conductor" immediately and I greeted warmly, chat for a while to understand that the passenger side of the conductor is the rainforest together with the Venezuelan boy, to the refugee camps when washing clothes together to see him all red, I also gave him from the country to bring the coffee cream, the original kid still remember me, we me alone to do the roadside immediately let the driver to stop, and the driver to stop, and the driver to stop, 19.30 to Tegucigalpa, no police on the road. 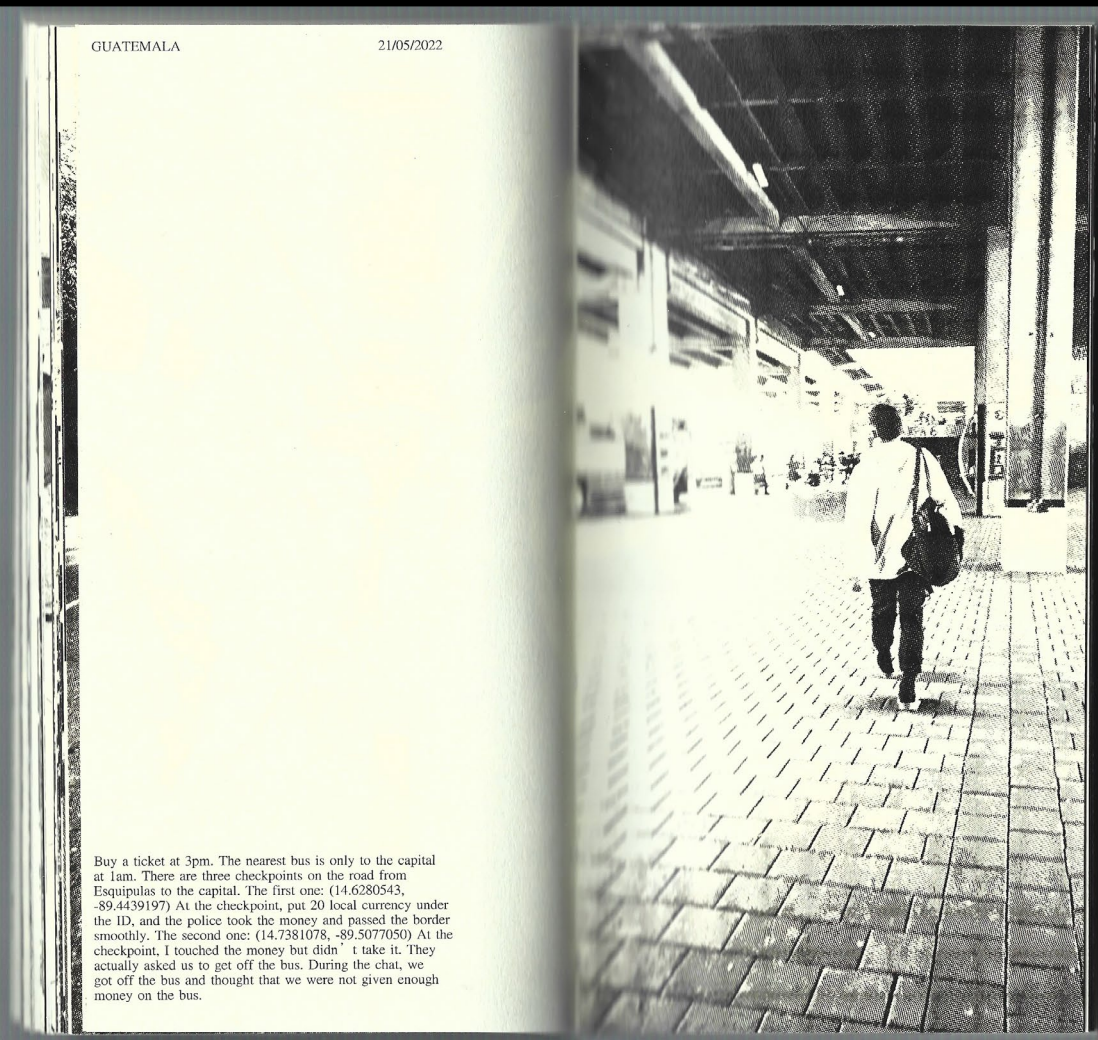
OCCOTEPEQUE 21/05/2022

Get the border here. Occotepeque, 8:00 pm to buy the same day 940 pm ticket, 550 local currency, take a copy of the passport on the line. This trip is around San Pedro Sula's whole sat almost 12 hours, in the middle of the encounter two checkpoints, out of the city that into the car in front of a one by one check, the back of a small bench with a bad pass, they all raised the hand of the paper, I also took a copy of the passport followed by lifting the mixed part. The second is from San Pedro Sula to Occotepeque road about 1:00 am, this time more directly all called off one by one check, I didn't get out of the car, so I told the Venezuelan guy to help me talk to him and gave him 500 local coins. After getting out of the car, the guy dragged the two policemen to talk to me and I couldn't understand what they were talking about while standing next to him, and we were sent to the car in about 15 minutes. When we got on the bus, the guy wanted to give me my money back, but I didn't ask for it, so I gave him the money for his words. We arrived in Occotepeque around 7am.



GUATEMALA 21/05/2022

Get off the car and take a taxi directly to the border. Get off as soon as you get to the border checkpoint. Soon someone will come and ask for \$25 to take you into the mountains, bypass the checkpoint, and go directly into the mountains and onto the Guatemalan highway. The mountain roads are not difficult to walk, they are all hard rock roads. It takes an estimated 40 minutes to walk. We arrived at the Guatemala Highway at 9 a.m. on May 16th. Find a regular taxi and go directly to Escquipulas Bus Station 14.5605663, 89.3523820 to buy a ticket. The ticket price is 120 local currency.



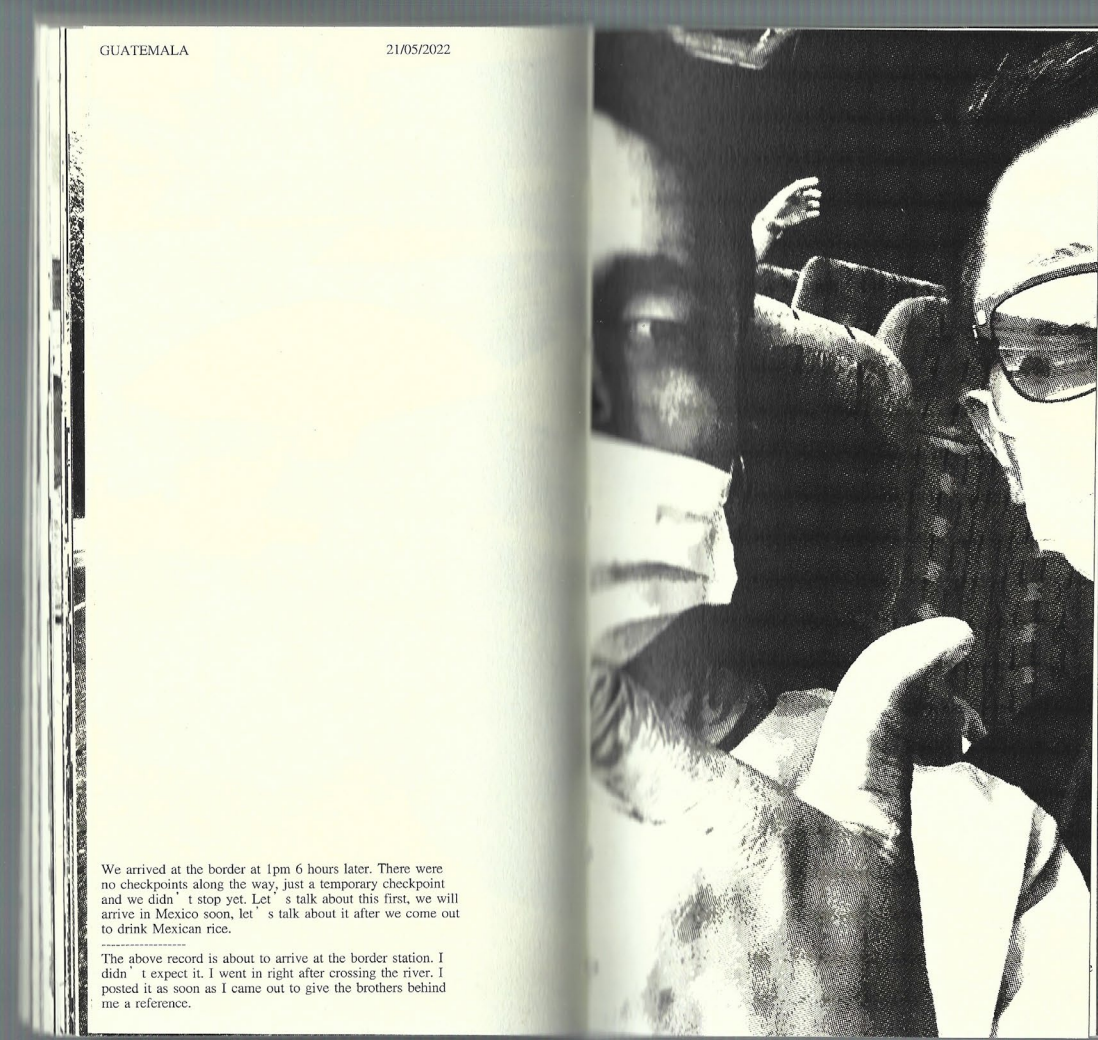
GUATEMALA 21/05/2022

Buy a ticket at 3pm. The nearest bus is only to the capital at 1am. There are three checkpoints on the road from Escquipulas to the capital. The first one: (14.6388543, -89.4439197) At the checkpoint, put 20 local currency under the ID, and the police took the money and passed the border smoothly. The second one: (14.7381078, -89.5077050) At the checkpoint, I reached the money but didn't take it. They actually asked us to get off the bus. During the chat, we got off the bus and thought that we were not given enough money on the bus.



GUATEMALA 21/05/2022

We just passed the three Guatemalan checkpoints not far from each other. To put it bluntly, they were happy to give me 10 dollars. Don't give more than that. It would cause trouble for yourself. After a thrilling night, I arrived in the capital at dawn on the morning of the 16th. After getting off the bus, I took a taxi directly to the city rapid transit station (14.558820, -90.5662851), with the viaduct above and the bus station below. I went in to find the Tecum Uman bus. The ticket cost about 130 local currency.



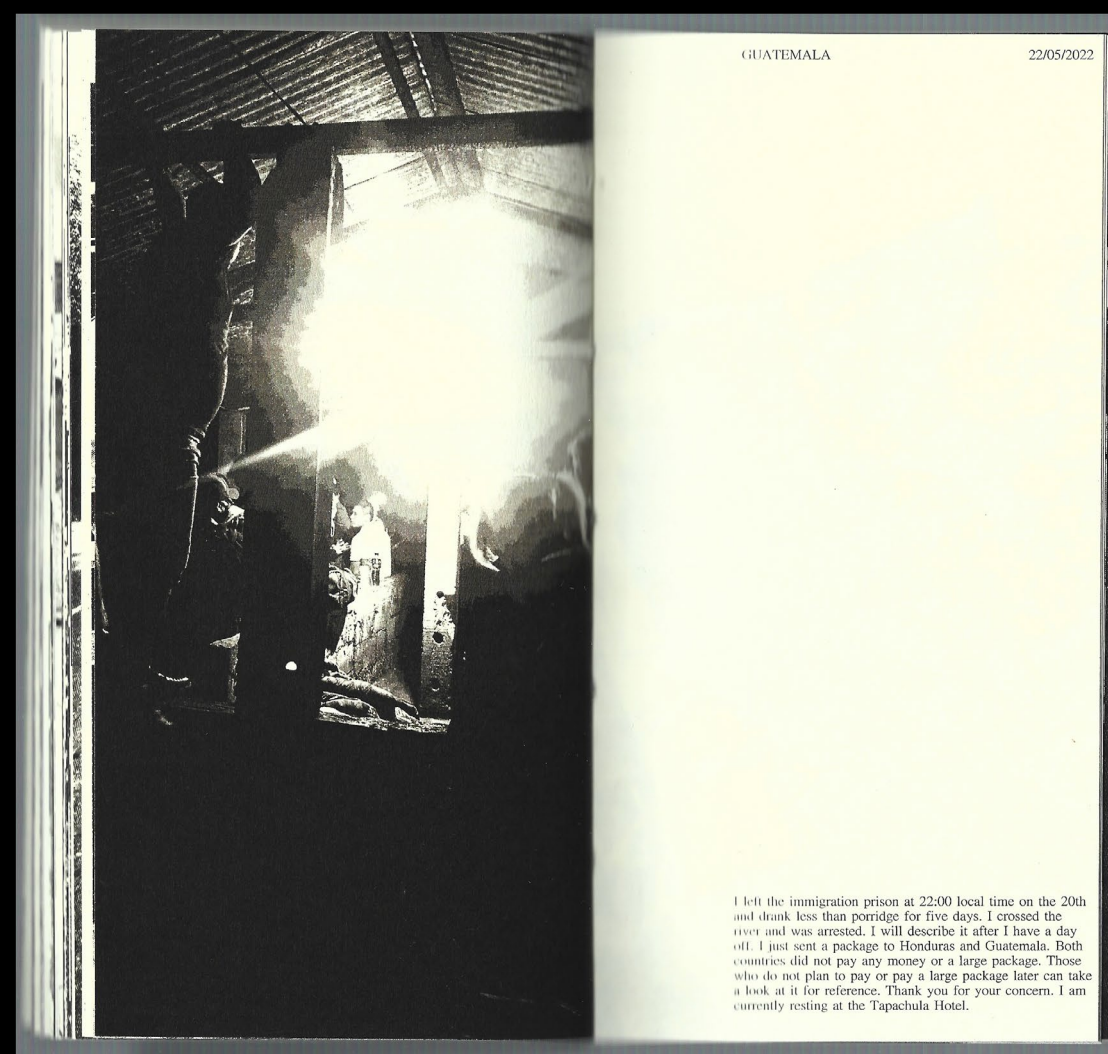
GUATEMALA 21/05/2022

We arrived at the border at 1pm 6 hours later. There were no checkpoints along the way, just a temporary checkpoint and we didn't stop yet. Let's talk about this first, we will arrive in Mexico soon, let's talk about it after we come out to drink Mexican rice.

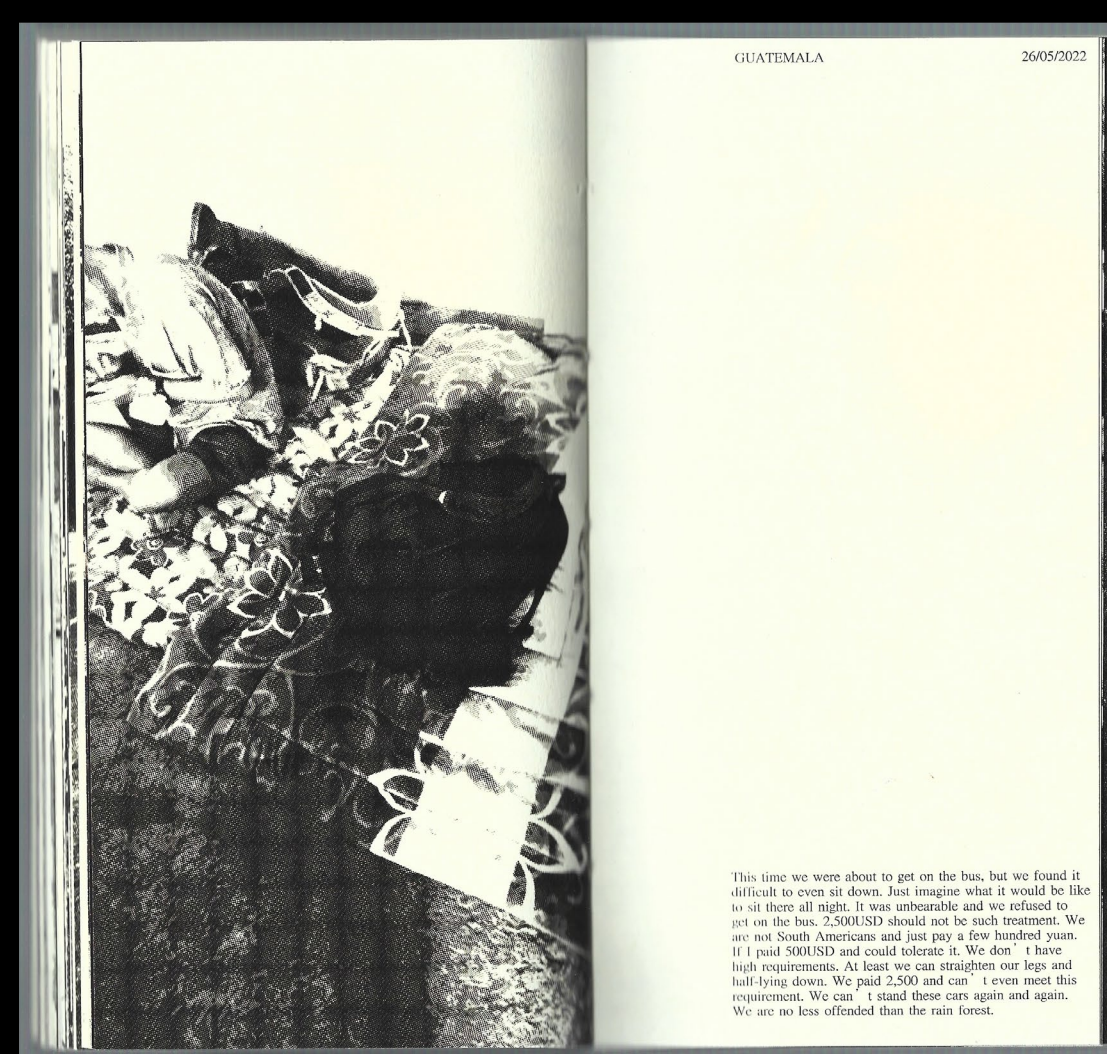
The above record is about to arrive at the border station. I didn't expect it. I went in right after crossing the river. I posted it as soon as I came out to give the brothers behind me a reference.



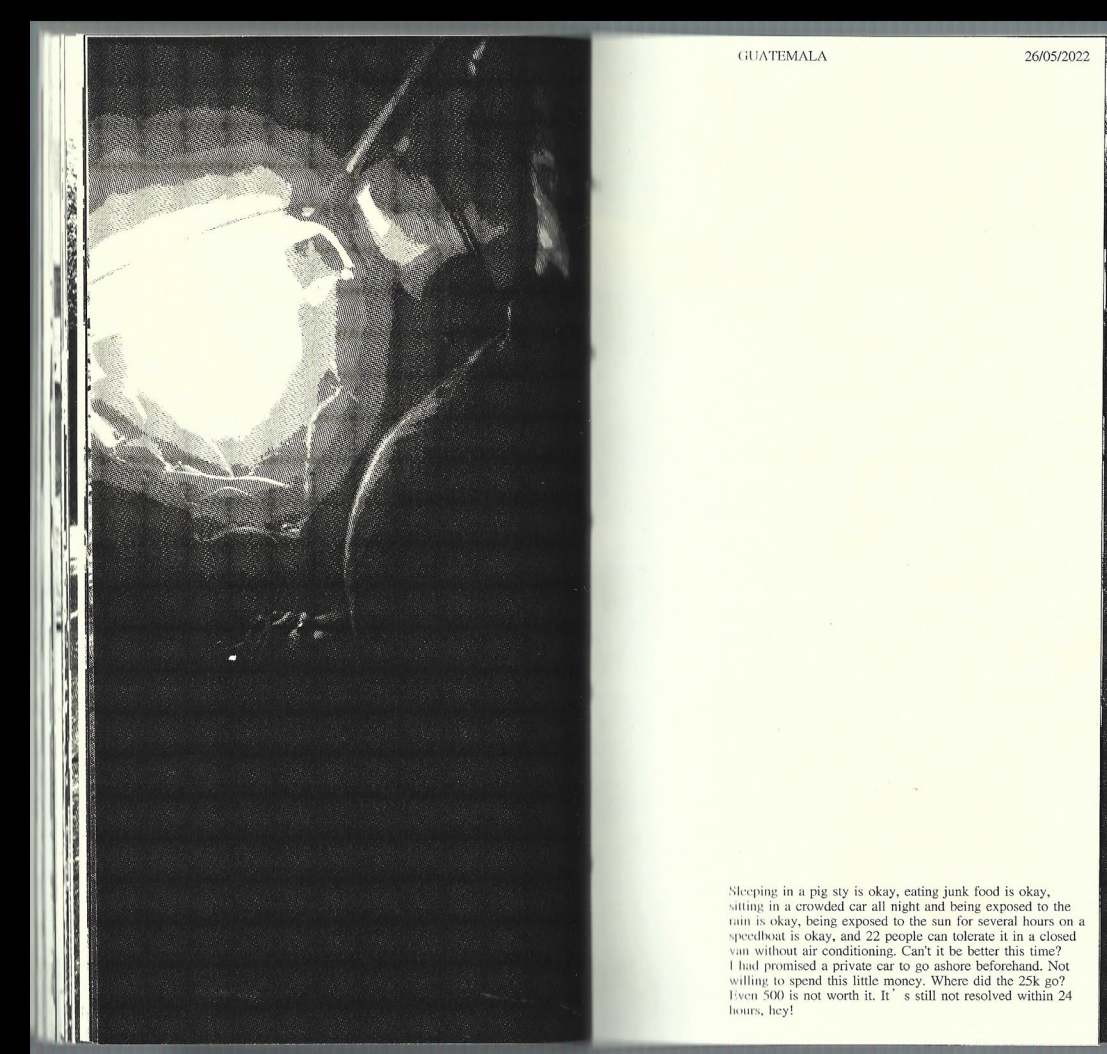
I left the immigration prison at 22:00 local time on the 20th and thank less than porridge for five days. I crossed the river and was arrested. I will describe it after I have a day off. I just sent a package to Honduras and Guatemala. Both countries did not pay any money or a large package. Those who do not plan to pay or pay a large package later can take a look at it for reference. Thank you for your concern. I am currently resting at the Tapachula Hotel.



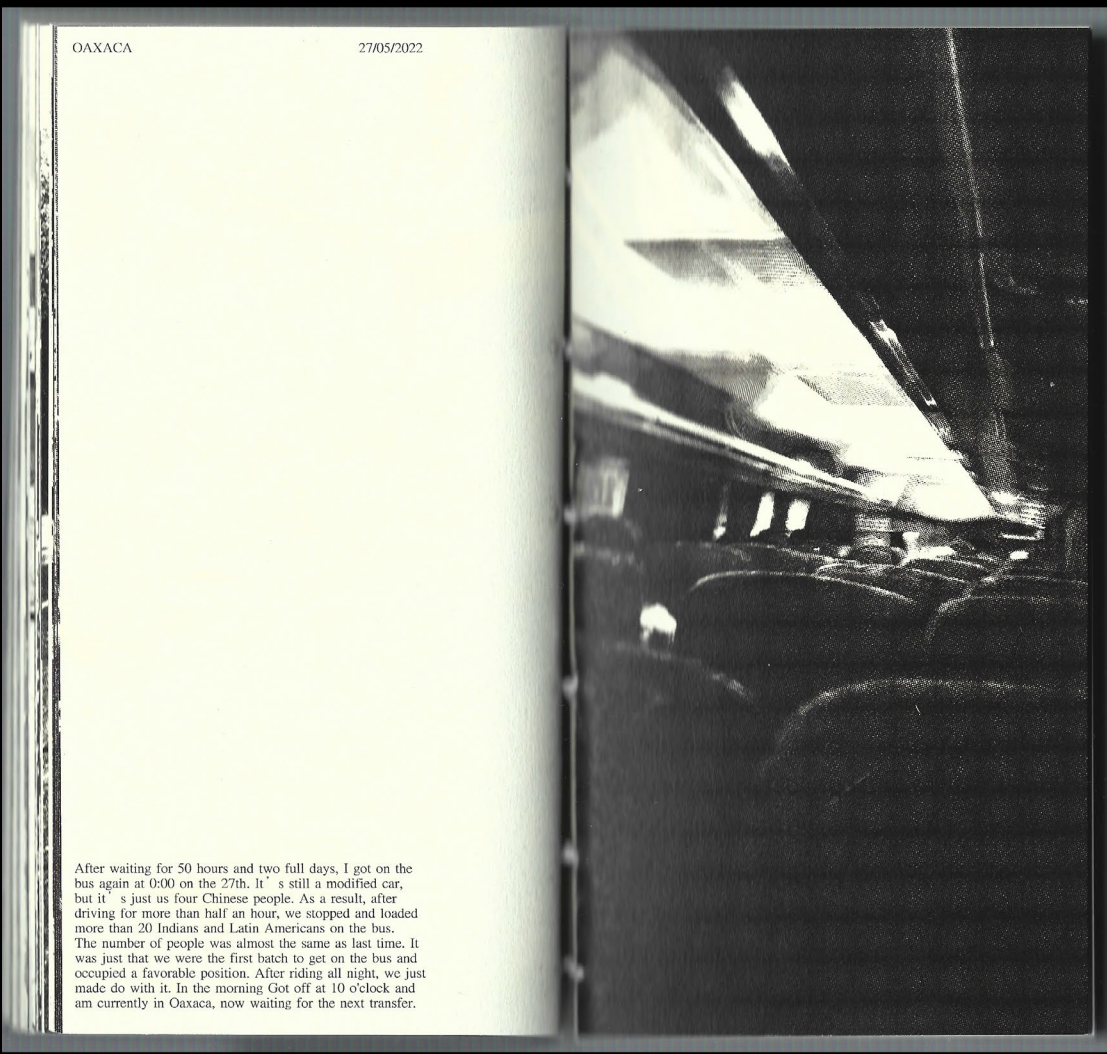
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This time we were about to get on the bus, but we found it difficult to even sit down. Just imagine what it would be like to sit there all night. It was unbearable and we refused to get on the bus. 2,500USD should not be such treatment. We are not South Americans and just pay a few hundred yuan. If I paid 500USD and could tolerate it. We don't have high requirements. At least we can straighten our legs and half lying down. We paid 2,500 and can't even meet this requirement. We can't stand these cars again and again. We are no less offended than the rain forest.



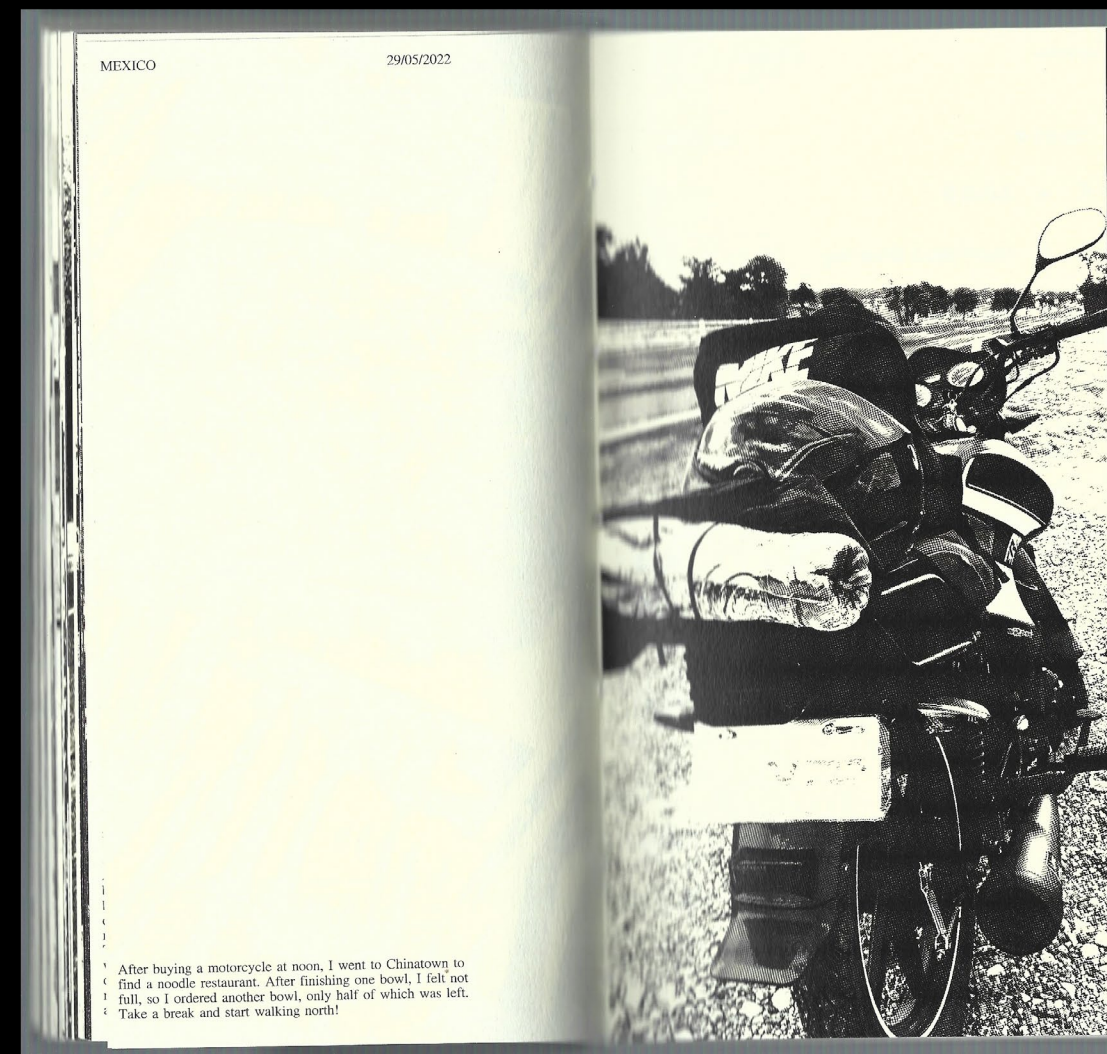
Sleeping in a pig sty is okay, eating junk food is okay, sitting in a crowded car all night and being exposed to the sun is okay, being exposed to the sun for several hours on a speedboat is okay, and 22 people can tolerate it in a closed van without air conditioning. Can't it be better this time? I had promised a private car to go ashore beforehand. Not willing to spend this little money. Where did the 25k go? Even 500 is not worth it. It's still not resolved within 24 hours, hey!



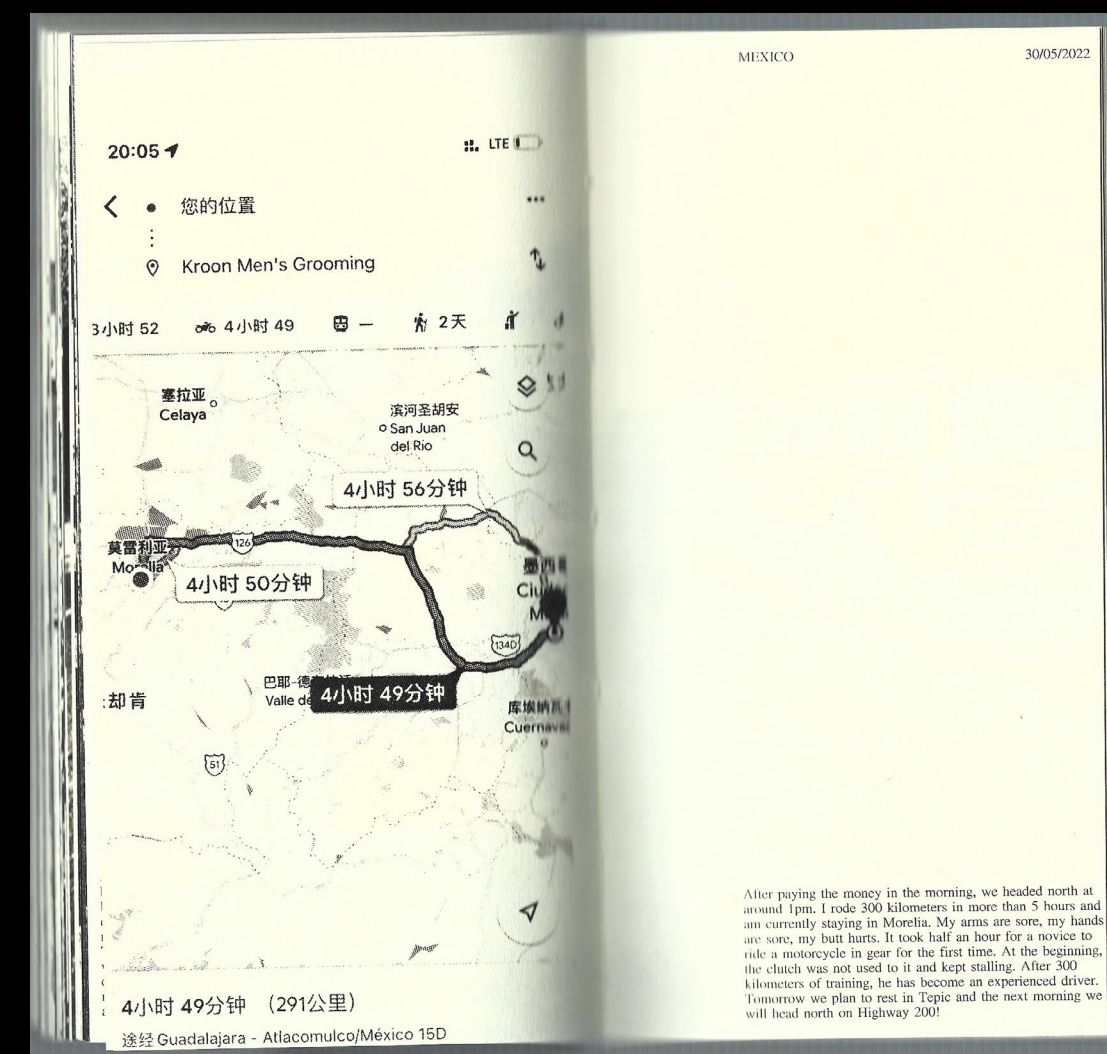
After waiting for 50 hours and two full days, I got on the bus again at 0:00 on the 27th. It's still a modified car, but it's just us four Chinese people. As a result, after driving for more than half an hour, we stopped and loaded more than 20 Indians and Latin Americans on the bus. The number of people was almost the same as last time. It was just that we were the first batch to get on the bus and occupied a favorable position. After riding all night, we just made do with it. In the morning I got off at 10 o'clock and am currently in Oaxaca, now waiting for the next transfer.



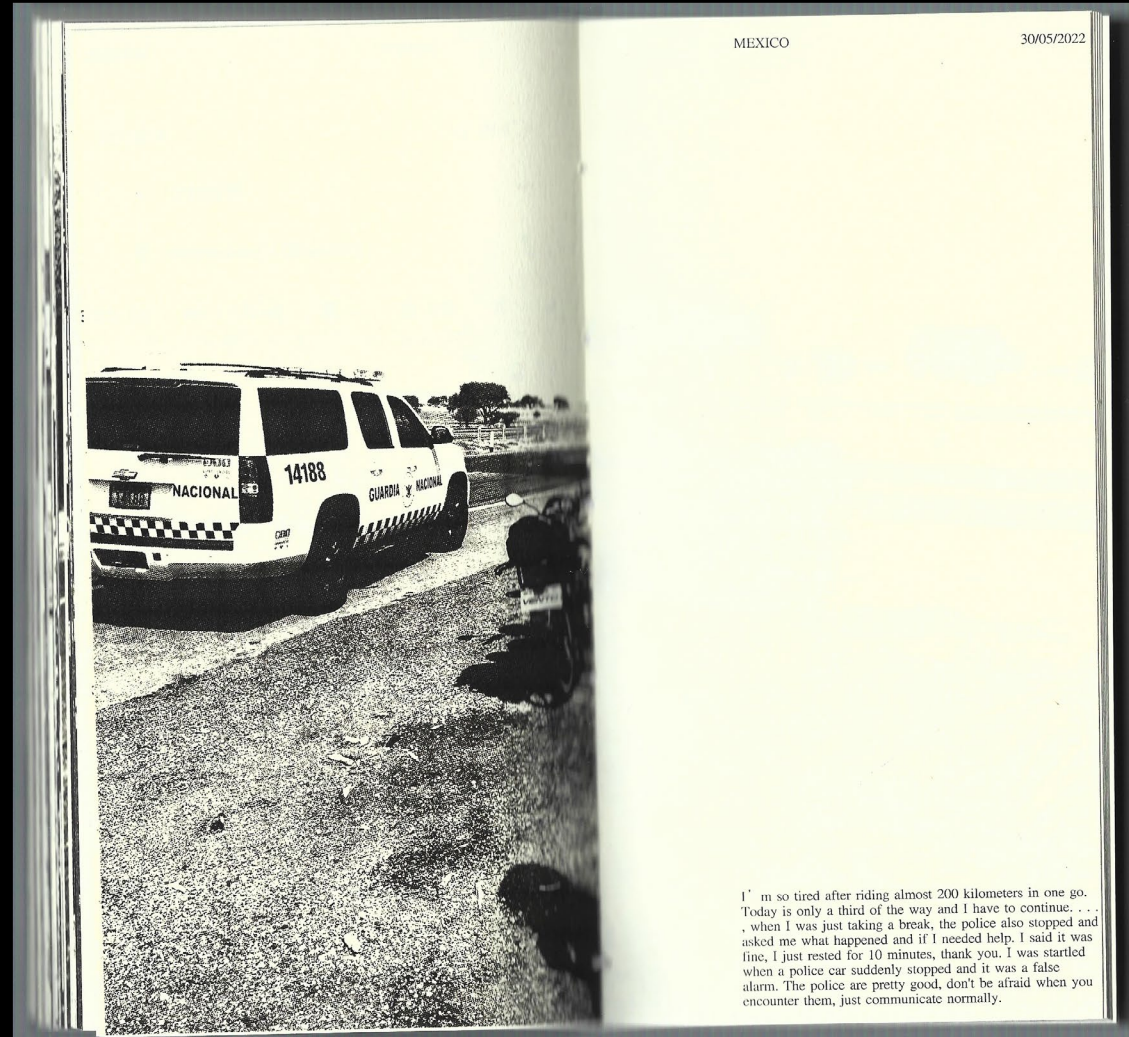
I just arrived in Mexico City for more than an hour. After arriving in Oaxaca, it was a taxi + private car + bus. The journey from Oaxaca to Mexico City took about 24 hours, which was relatively easy. But the journey from Tapachula to Oaxaca is difficult. You need to think carefully about the big package, and the price of 2,500 US dollars is definitely a rip-off. The hotel owner just acts as a salesperson and can't contribute to the whole process. Take the big head. You can make money with poor information, but the appearance is too ugly.



After buying a motorcycle at noon, I went to Chinatown to find a noodle restaurant. After finishing one bowl, I felt not full, so I ordered another bowl, only half of which was left. Take a break and start walking north!



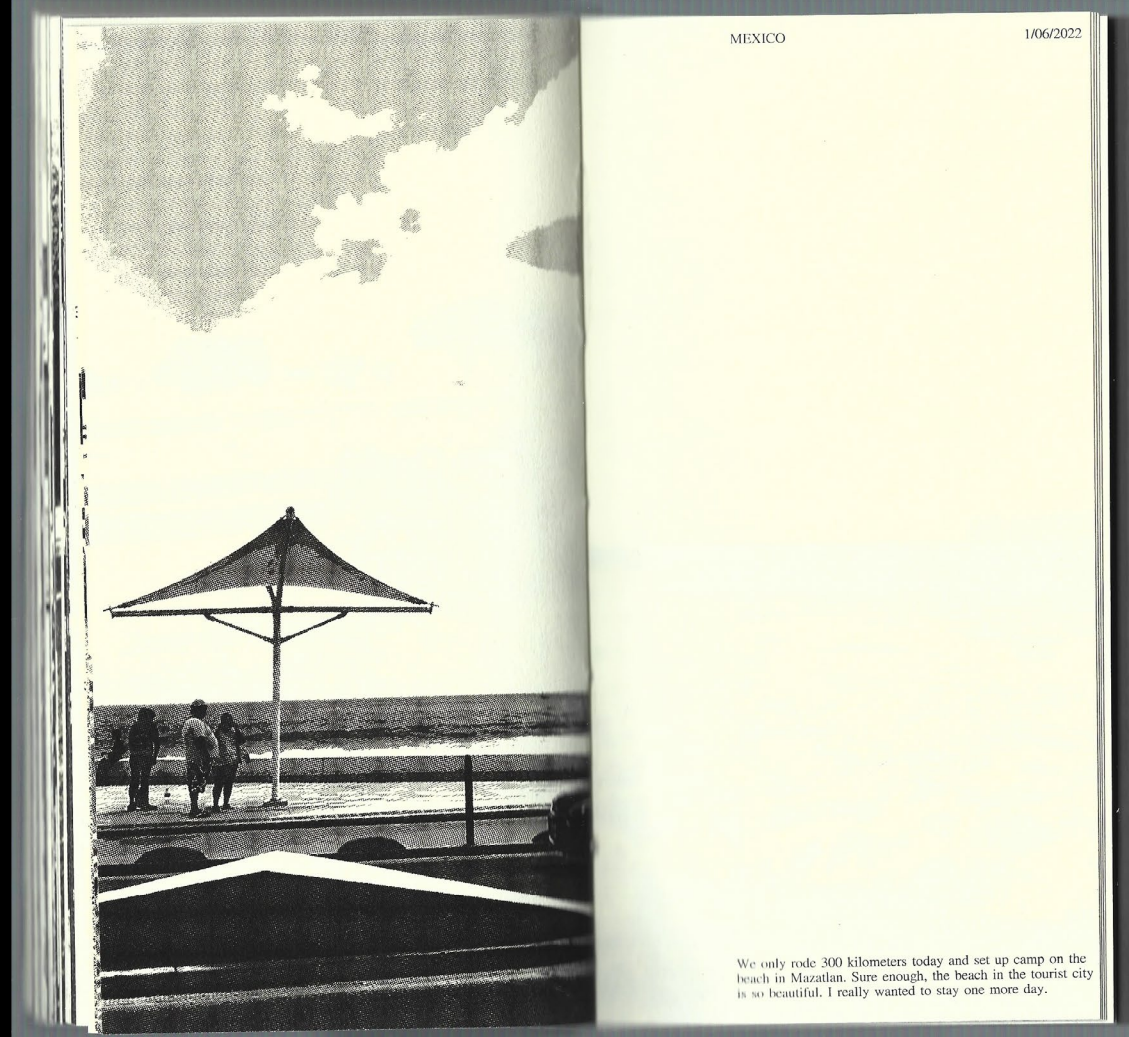
After paying the money in the morning, we headed north at around 1pm. I rode 300 kilometers in more than 5 hours and am currently staying in Morelia. My arms are sore, my hands are sore, my butt hurts. It took half an hour for a novice to ride a motorcycle in gear for the first time. At the beginning, the clutch was not used to it and kept stalling. After 300 kilometers of training, he has become an experienced driver. Tomorrow we plan to rest in Tzuc and the next morning we will head north on Highway 200!



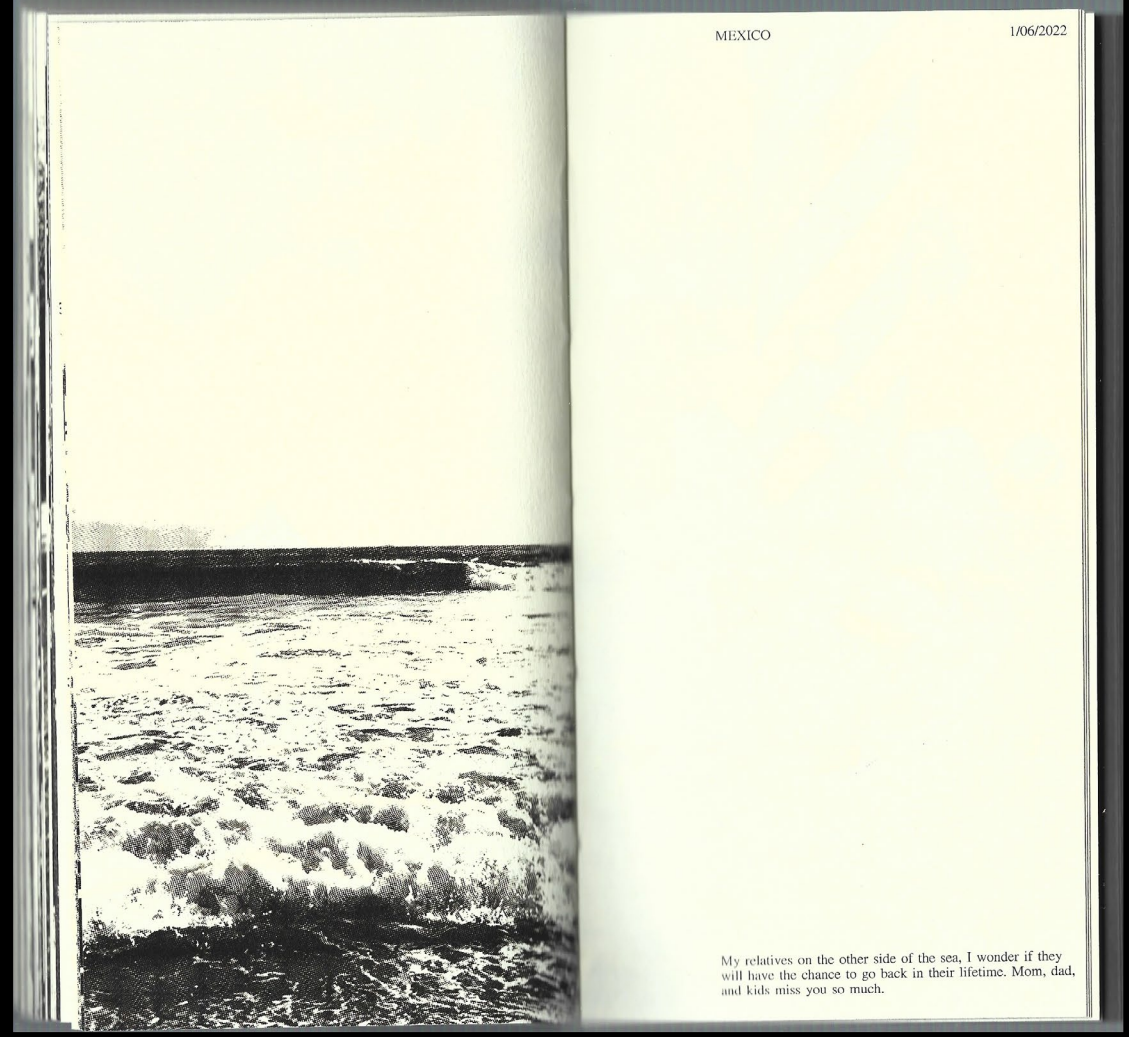
I'm so tired after riding almost 200 kilometers in one go. Today is only a third of the way and I have to continue... when I was just taking a break, the police also stopped and asked me what happened and if I needed help. I said it was fine. I just rested for 10 minutes, thank you. I was startled when a police car suddenly stopped and it was a false alarm. The police are pretty good, don't be afraid when you encounter them, just communicate normally.



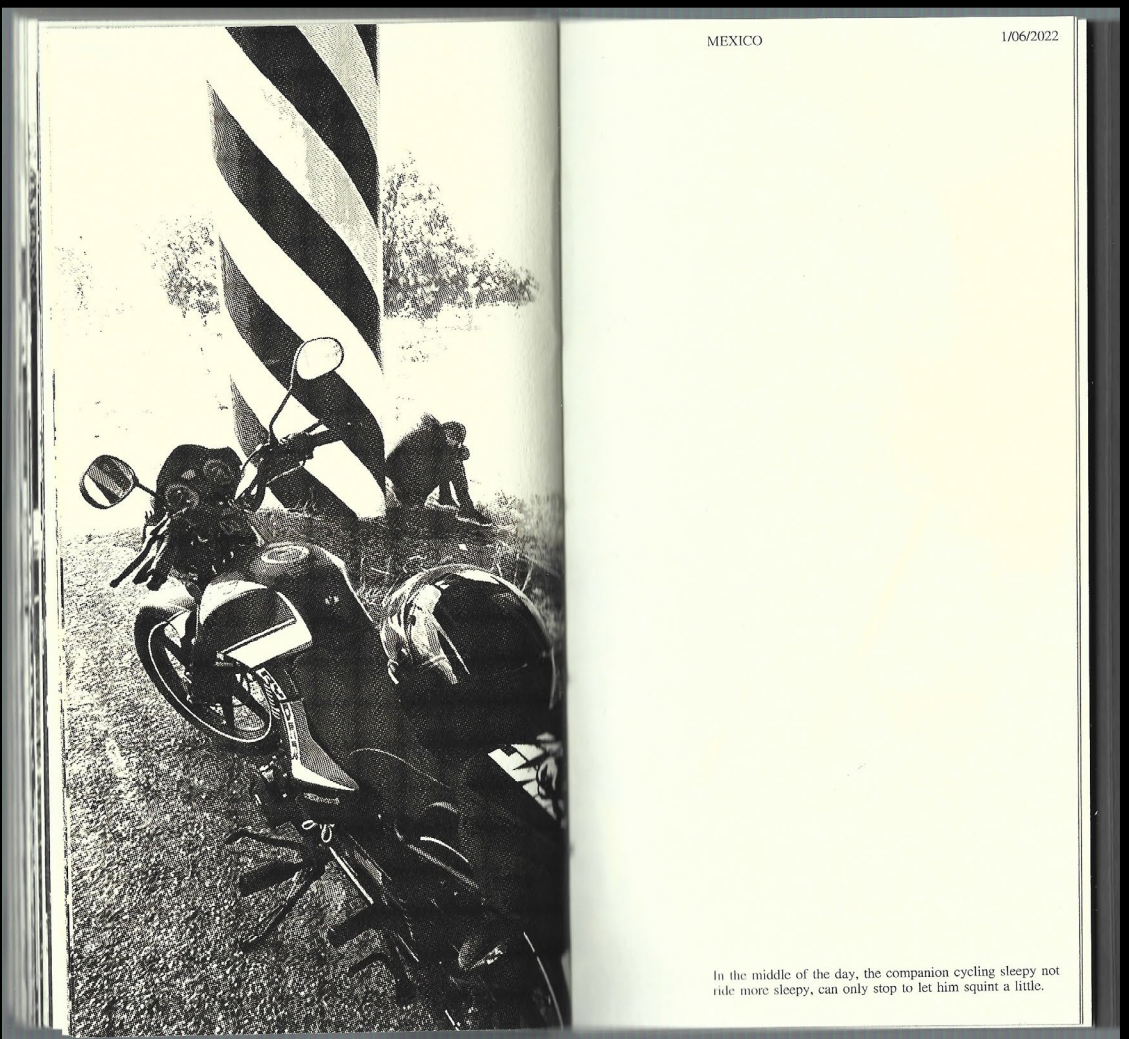
Today, the 30th, I arrived safely from Moctla to Tepic in one day. I was so tired from the entire 500 kilometers that I couldn't even walk after getting out of the car. Before I started riding, I felt that 800 kilometers a day was not unrealistic, but now I know that 500 kilometers is the same as a day. Highway 15d from Moctla to Tepic is basically a lilly and over-mountain road all the way to the west. The road conditions are excellent, similar to domestic highways. Most of the road sections are tolled, but they are very cheap. Tomorrow we can take Highway 15d and head north!



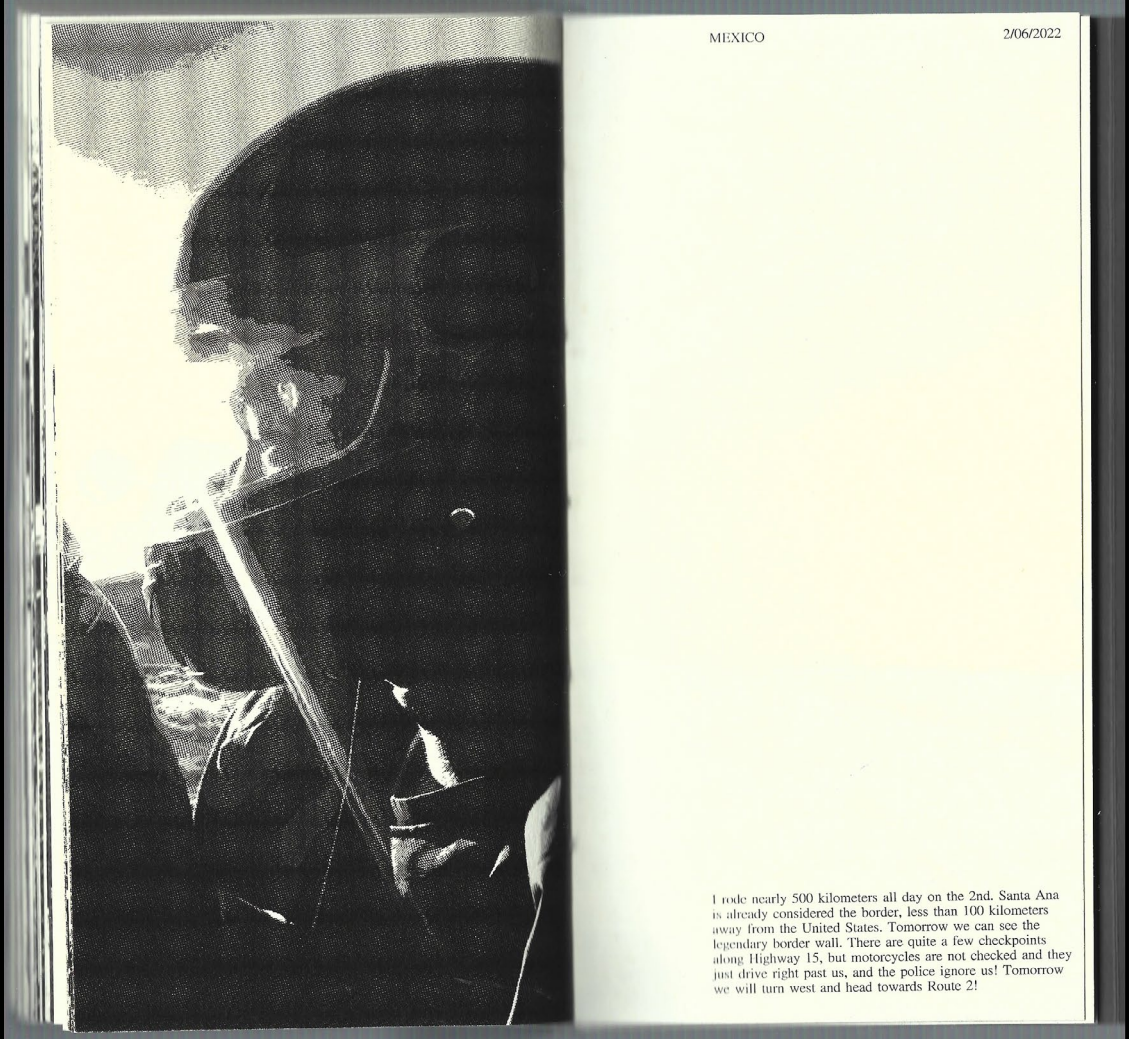
We only rode 300 kilometers today and set up camp on the beach in Mazatlan. Sure enough, the beach in the tourist city is so beautiful. I really wanted to stay one more day.



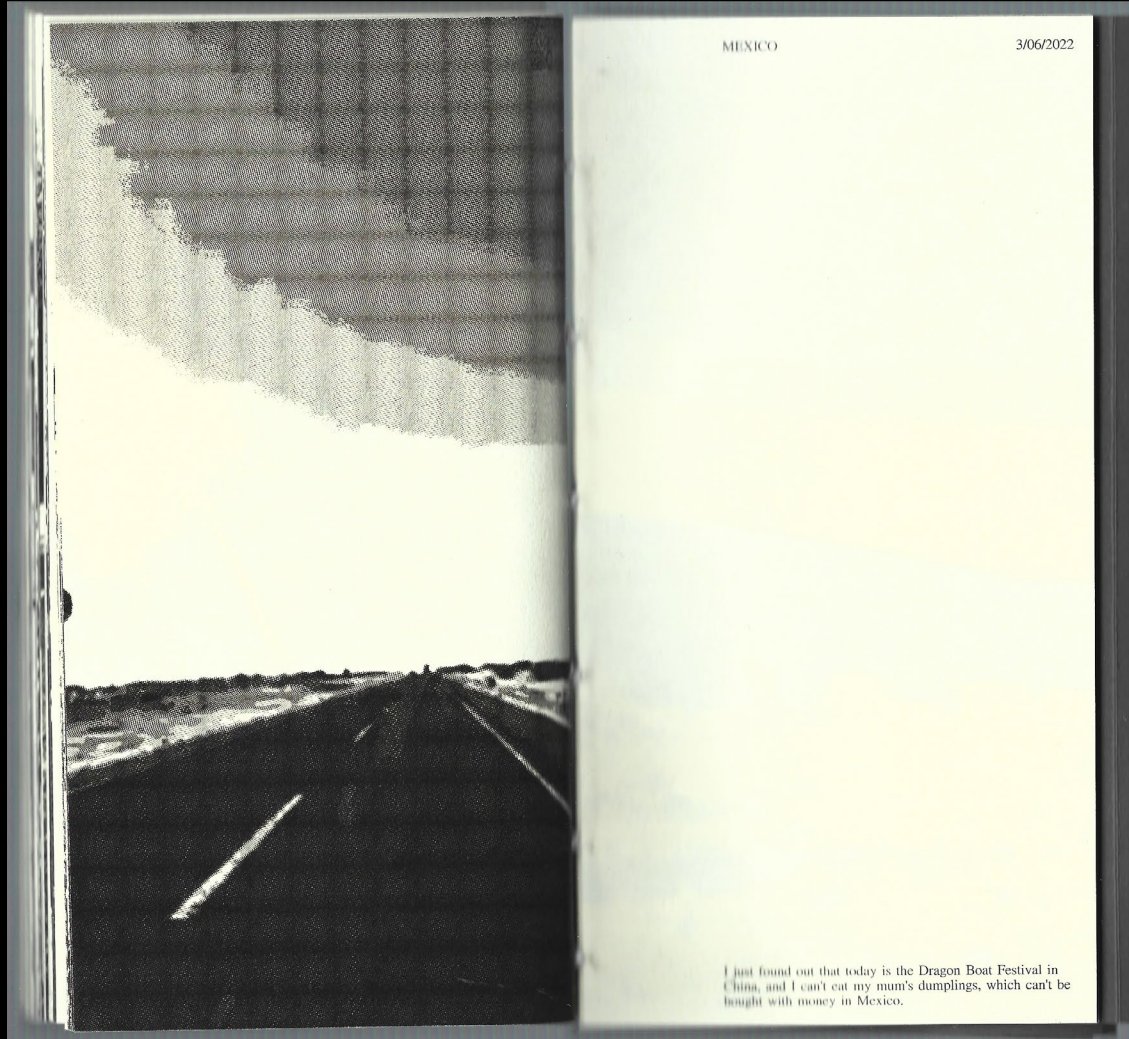
My relatives on the other side of the sea. I wonder if they will have the chance to go back in their lifetime. Mom, dad, and kids miss you so much.



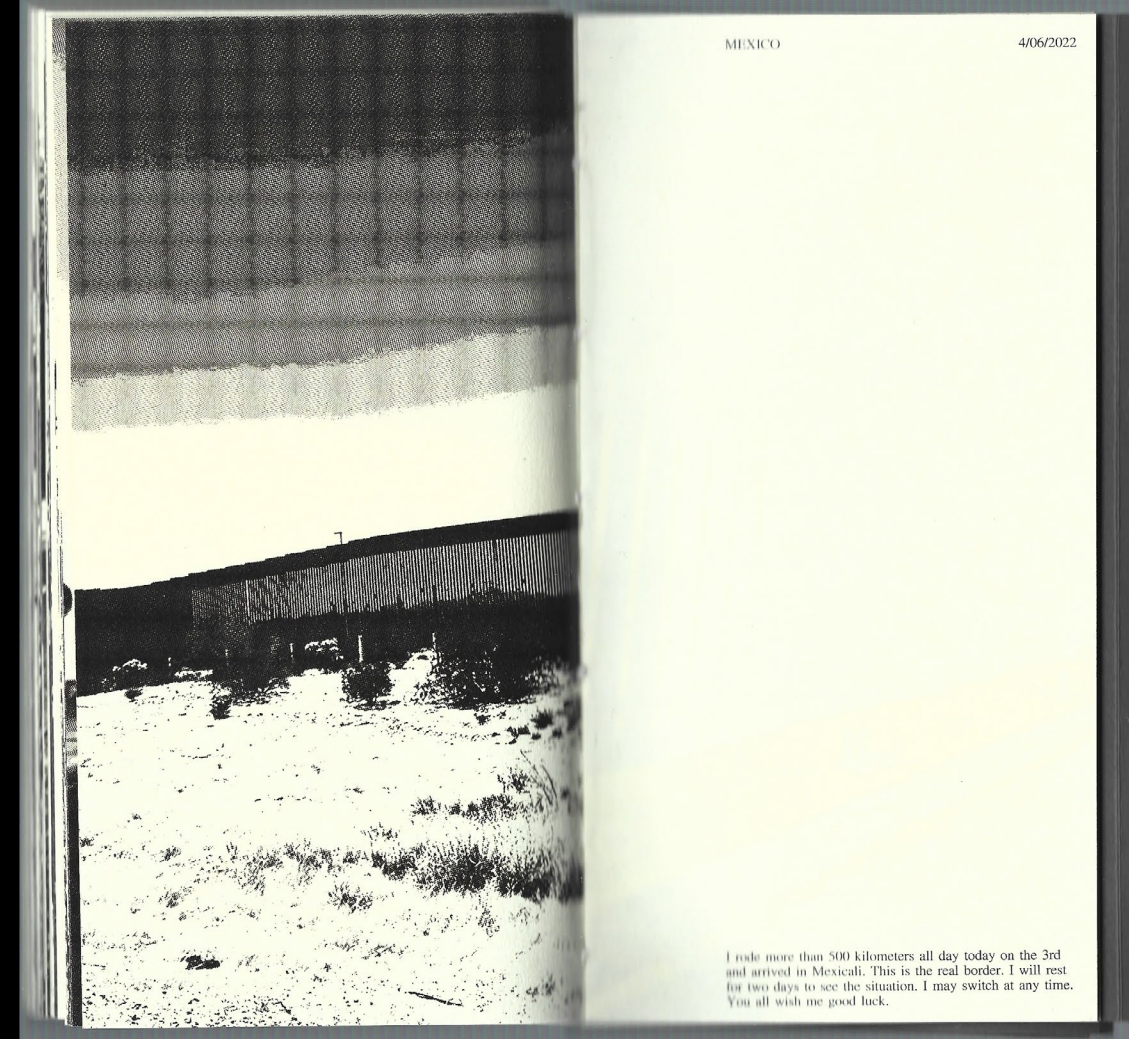
In the middle of the day, the companion cycling sleepy not ride more sleepy, can only stop to let him squint a little.



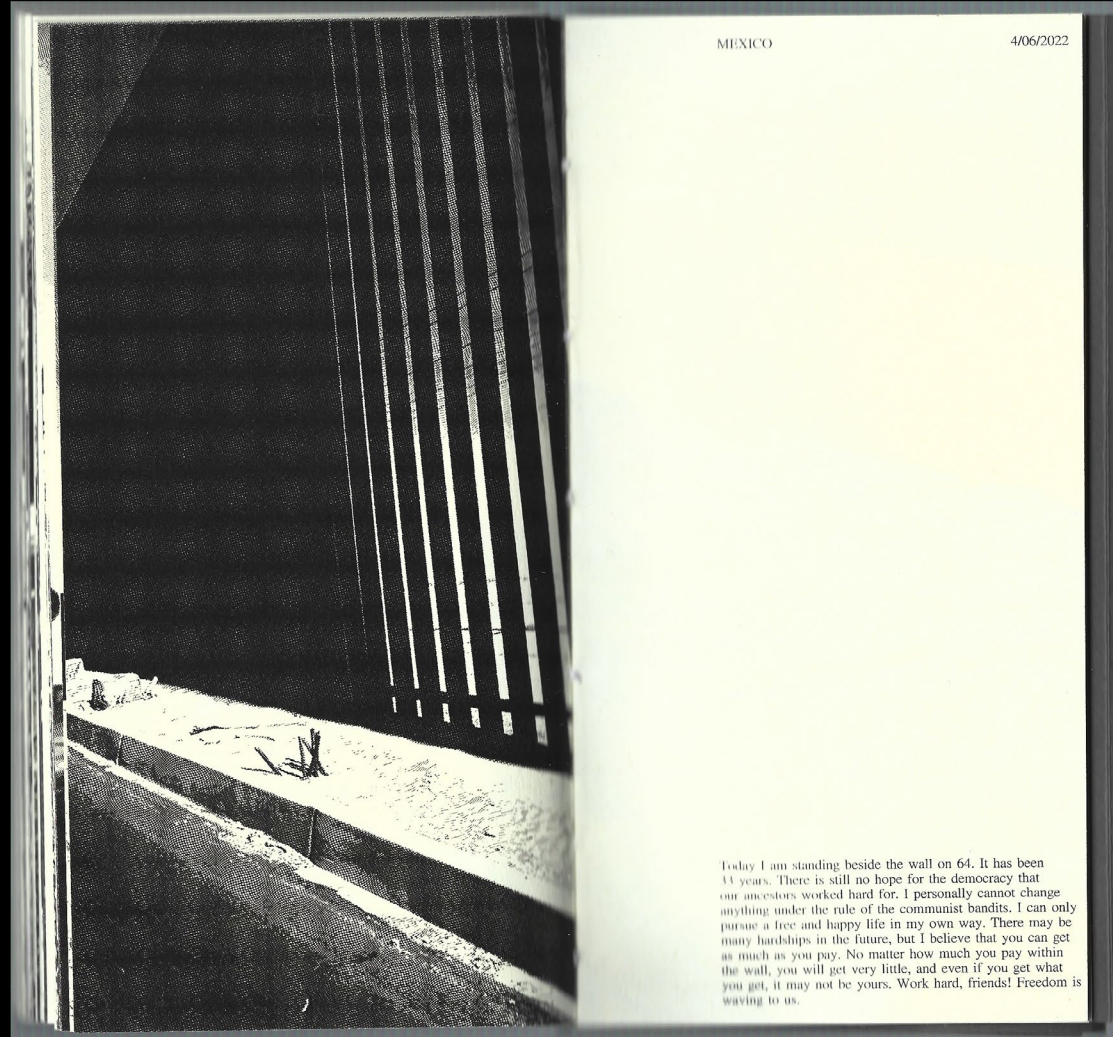

Tomorrow we will turn west and head towards Route 2!



I just found out that today is the Dragon Boat Festival in China, and I can't eat my mum's dumplings, which can't be bought with money in Mexico.



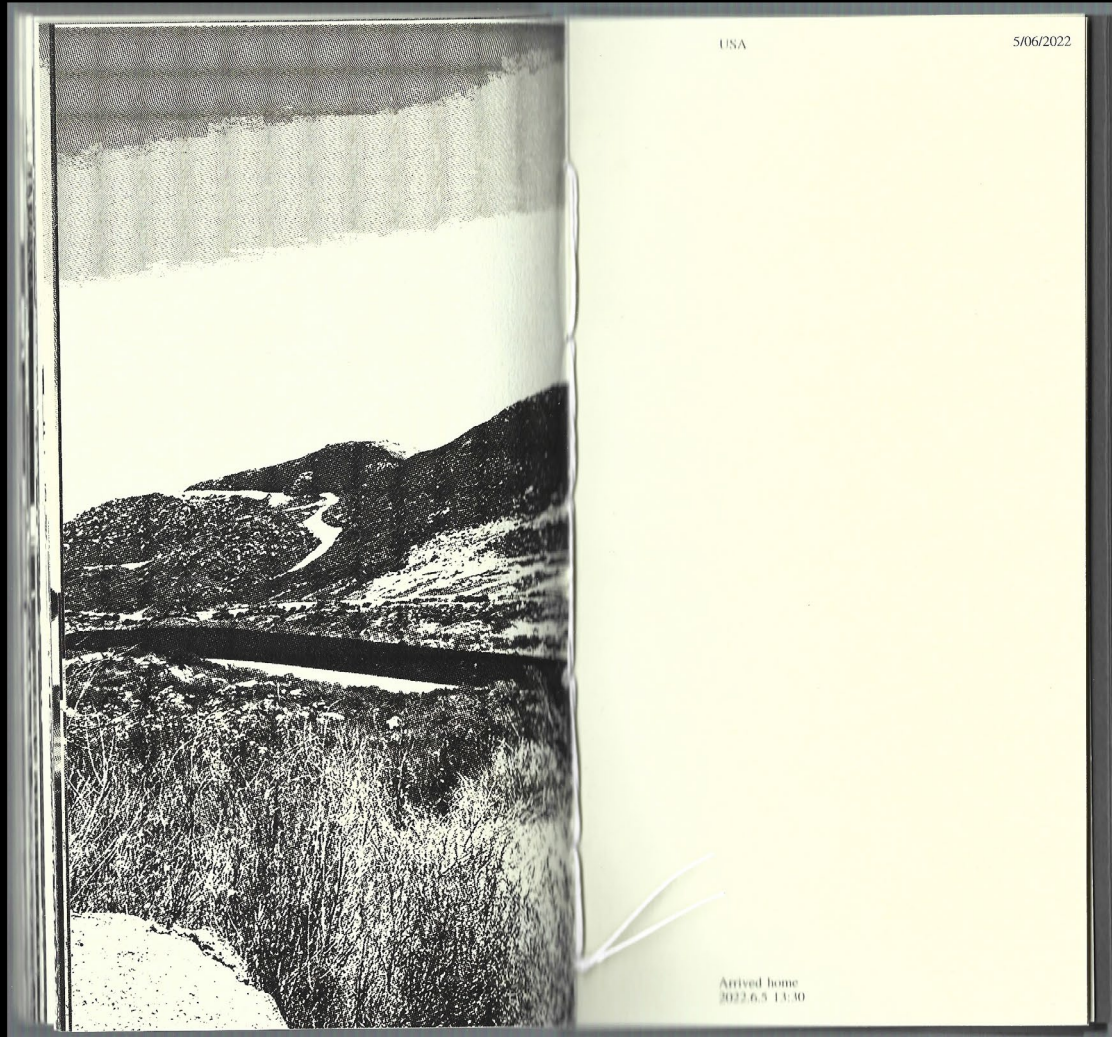
I rode more than 500 kilometers all day today on the 3rd and arrived in Mexicali. This is the real border. I will rest for two days to see the situation. I may switch at any time. You all wish me good luck.

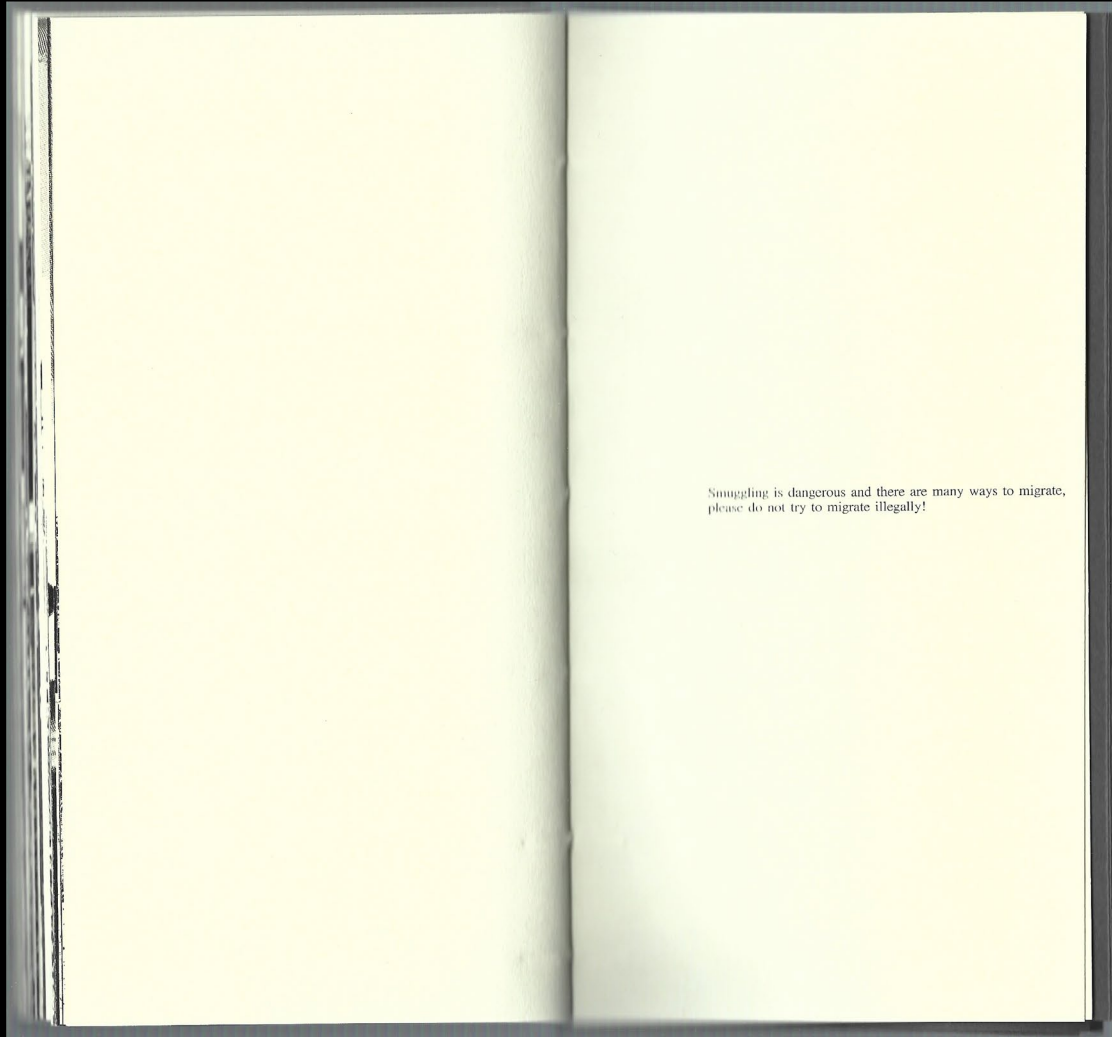
