

Lighting installation



The light control device is used to visualise the user's individual health rating and social identity in this design system setup. The device collects real-time physical and psychological data from the monitoring garment and uploads it to the Utopian Government's system database, which automatically changes the colour of the light according to the scoring results, visually displaying the wearer's current health level. The light colour is divided into five categories: purple (elite health), blue (excellent health), green (standard health), red (qualified health) and grey (low or unmanageable health), which correspond to different social classifications and access to resources. The device is designed to make health status a public and recognisable social label, thus allowing participants to reflect on whether sacrificing personal privacy and freedom is justified if health is the foundation of social stability.
