Look 2 - Front



The way the collar falls onto neck is similar to the way a petal falls on a stem
- Maybe reinforce slightly but cut of the collar will allow it to stand without.

Look 2 - final fitting



- Skirt colour blocking for base layer.
To be layered with tonal, gathered chiffon

- Need to add waistband to skirt which will lower hem at centre front
